Representatives of the Intelligence Community met on 24 April to discuss the following issues: bombing in Djibouti, current Libyan terrorist activities, and liquid explosives as a terrorist weapon. Attached is my report.

## 1. Djibouti

On 18 March a briefcase bomb (approximately 15-20 kgs) exploded at a cafe frequented by the French in Djibouti.

Adouani Hamoudab Hassen, a Tunisian, was arrested at the Djibouti airport enroute to Aden. He confessed to planting the bomb and claimed he was recruited in Damascus and charged to kill as many people as possible. He said he was a member of the Revolutionary Resistance Troops.

It is unclear who is responsible for the attack. There are several possibilities:

- --Djiboutian dissidents. The blast occurred five weeks before the presidential election. A known dissident, Aden Robleh, has conducted similar bombings in the past.
- --Libya. The anti-France target may be an effort to punish Paris for its Chad policy. The use of a Tunisian surrogate also suggests Libyan involvement.
- --LARF. The anti-France nature of the attack fits the threats made against France afrer the Abdullah trial.
