SUBJECT: Peripheral Warning Issues

The following warning issues developed by the National Warning Staff are somewhat marginal and fall below the threshold for our Bi-Weekly. I thought, however, that you should be aware of them.

b. South Korea. South Korean student demonstrations are taking on a decidedly more anti-American slant. On 18 May, a USAF tactical vehicle with four American military passengers was caught in heavy traffic in Seoul near a student demonstration. [Redacted]

[Redacted] the vehicle was attacked by students with "sticks and clubs" and a Molotov cocktail was thrown; the vehicle escaped with little damage. Potentially, however, the incident could have resulted in the death of some of the Americans, with all the attendant political fallout.
