In the 1970s, there were a number of assassination attempts

Shevardnadze in 1973 and 1976. There are rumors that	
both were caused by his crackdown on corruption. (Based	
on press and embassy reporting.)

Since 1980, most of the assassinations or attempts have been "in-party," and have been motivated by official crackdowns on corruption. These include:

- -- The murder in 1978 of the Azeri Minister of Internal
 Affairs and three of his associates. (Soviet press)
- -- The assassination of the Kirghiz Prime Minister at a spa in 1980. (Soviet press)
- -- Two attempts on the life of then Rostov First Secretary

 (and current Minister of Internal Affairs) Vlasov in 1984

 and 1985. (Embassy sources)
- -- Several threats against the Moscow First Secretary and other members of the Yeltsin family in 1986. (Embassy sources)
