

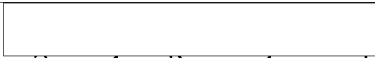

James Taylor

An important responsibility of all senior Agency managers is the determination of resource requirements.
