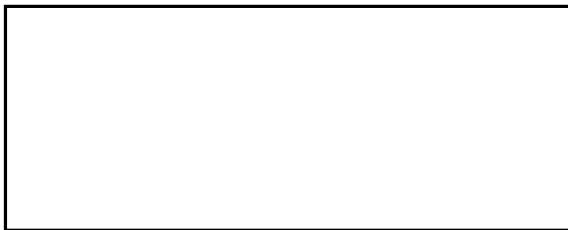

Foreign intelligence on the economic, political and technical factors affecting energy supply in international markets and in individual foreign countries. Key intelligence includes data on energy supply/demand balances, prices, national and international energy policies, and the political and institutional forces influencing policy decisions in these areas.

The IC Staff, I know from last year's experience, will consider these contributions only as grist for its mill, and its resulting draft will look quite different on these subjects.
