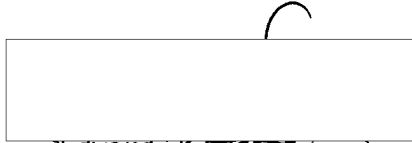

1. The HPSCI markup of the FY 1990-1991 NFIP Budget includes a requirement for a Presidential Report describing how intelligence activities relating to narcotics trafficking can be integrated across all facets of the intelligence cycle. Emphasis is placed on the dissemination of intelligence information to officials responsible for narcotics policy and enforcement (see attached, extracted from the HPSCI markup).

2. To this end, I request that the Counternarcotics Center begin work that will lead to the requested report being signed by the President and transmitted to Congress by 1 April 1990.

**PRESIDENTIAL REPORT ON COORDINATION OF DRUG  
INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES**

**SEC. 704. Not later than April 1, 1990, the President shall submit to Congress a report describing how intelligence activities relating to narcotics trafficking can be integrated, including coordinating the collection and analysis of intelligence information, ensuring the dissemination of relevant intelligence information to officials with responsibility for narcotics policy and to agencies of the U.S. Government responsible for interdiction, eradication, law enforcement, and other counternarcotics activities, and coordinating and controlling all counternarcotics intelligence activities.**
