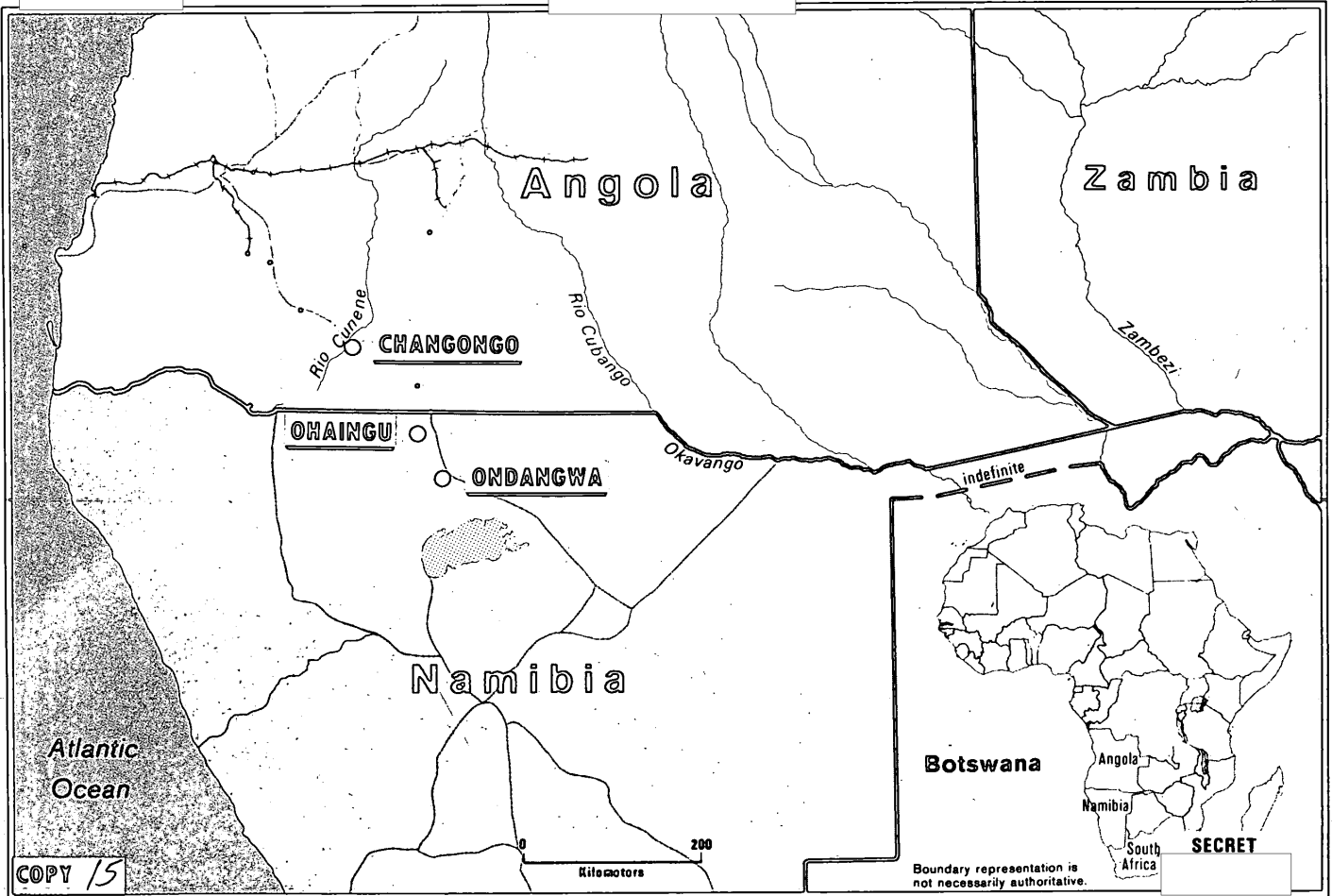

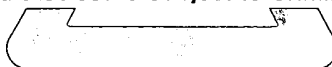

1. SIGNIFICANCE: PREPARATIONS FOR SOUTH AFRICAN COMBAT OPERATIONS ARE OBSERVED AT ONDANGWA, CHANGONGO, AND OHAINGU. (SWN)

2. REMARKS: AT ONDANGWA AIRFIELD [REDACTED] 10 MIRAGE F.1 MULTIROLE FIGHTER AIRCRAFT AND ONE DC-4/6 COMBAT SUPPORT AIRCRAFT HAVE DEPLOYED HERE [REDACTED] THE F.1 ARE IN NET-COVERED REVETMENTS NEAR THE WEST END OF THE AIRFIELD. THESE REVETMENTS ARE NORMALLY OCCUPIED BY IMPALA LIGHT-STRIKE AIRCRAFT. F.1 WERE LAST SEEN HERE [REDACTED] WHEN AT LEAST SIX POSSIBLE F.1 WERE OBSERVED IN THE NET-COVERED REVETMENTS. OTHER AIR ORDER-OF-BATTLE INCLUDES TWO IMPALA, THREE C-47 LIGHT TRANSPORT AIRCRAFT, TWO KUDU LIAISON/OBSERVATION AIRCRAFT, ONE LIGHT TWIN-ENGINE AIRCRAFT, ONE SMALL STRAIGHT-WING AIRCRAFT, FOUR PUMA MEDIUM HELICOPTERS, AND TWO ALOUETTE LIGHT HELICOPTERS. FIVE IMPALA, TWO L-100 MEDIUM TRANSPORT AIRCRAFT, TWO PUMA, AND TWO ALOUETTE III HAVE DEPARTED [REDACTED] (SWN)

ONDANGWA AIRFIELD, 36 NM SOUTH OF THE ANGOLA/NAMIBIA BORDER, IS A FORWARD DISPERSAL/COMBAT SUPPORT AIRFIELD FOR SOUTH AFRICAN FORCES. (SWN)

A SIGNIFICANT DECREASE IN GROUND FORCE EQUIPMENT IN THE ONDANGWA AREA HAS ALSO OCCURRED [REDACTED] SIXTEEN ELAND SCOUT CARS, FIVE BUFFEL LIGHT ARMOR VEHICLES, AND 20 TRUCKS ALONG THE MAIN ROAD HAVE DEPARTED. ELEVEN PRIME MOVERS, EIGHT ANTI-AIRCRAFT GUNS, 16 BUFFEL, AND 12 TRUCKS NEAR THE AIRFIELD SUPPORT AREA HAVE ALSO DEPARTED. (SWN)

AT CHANGONGO MILITARY AREA [REDACTED] MAJOR ELEMENTS OF A SOUTH AFRICAN MECHANIZED INFANTRY BATTALION (MECH INF BN) HAVE DEPARTED THE AREA [REDACTED] 35 RATEL ARMORED PERSONNEL CARRIERS, SIX POSSIBLE SCOUT CARS, SIX BUFFEL LIGHT ARMORED VEHICLES (LAV), AND 56 TRUCKS WERE PRESENT. AT LEAST FOUR TRUCKS REMAIN IN THE AREA. THIS MECH INF BN IS PROBABLY THE UNIT WHICH WAS ABSENT FROM OPERET MILITARY CAMP AND BATTALION HEADQUARTERS [REDACTED] (SWN)
