((EXCERPTS)) THE MONCLOA PACT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT AND THE  
OPPOSITION PARTIES HAS AROUSED VARIOUS TYPES OF REACTION.  
WE CAN SAY, FOR EXAMPLE, THAT THE TRADE UNIONS, WHICH WERE NOT  
REPRESENTED AT YESTERDAY'S MEETING, DO NOT SUBSCRIBE TO IT.

OF THE POLITICAL PARTIES, BUT AS FAR AS THE TRADE UNIONS ARE

CONCERNED, THE WHOLE QUESTION IS VIEWED FROM A DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVE.

IN OUR STUDIOS TONIGHT WE HAVE JOSE MIGUEL IBARROLA, SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE UNITARY TRADE UNION ((SU))

((IBARROLA)) ((SENTENCE INDISTINCT)) IN THE FIRST PLACE WE BELIEVE THAT THIS WAS A DECISION TAKEN WITHOUT CONSULTING THE TRADE UNIONS, WE DO NOT AGREE WITH THIS BECAUSE THE GOVERNMENT HAS NOT TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION THE TALKS IT HAS ((PENDING)) WITH US.

SECONDLY, ANY AGREEMENT ON ECONOMIC MATTERS WHICH DOES NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE PROBLEM OF LABOR RELATIONS SEEMS TO US UNACCEPTABLE, THE TRADE UNIONS HAVE ALWAYS MAINTAINED THAT THIS PROBLEM SHOULD COME BEFORE ANY ECONOMIC AGREEMENT.

THIRD, WE BELIEVE THAT, OUT OF THE FEW CONCRETE THINGS IN THE PROGRAM WHICH WAS AGREED ON THE MONCLOA PALACE, THERE ARE AGREEMENTS TO WHICH WE CANNOT ((SUBSCRIBE)), IN THE FIRST PLACE, WE BELIEVE THAT THERE ARE NO FUNDS DESIGNED TO CREATE JOBS, THE 100 BILLION PESETAS SUPPOSEDLY EARMARKED FOR SOCIAL SECURITY ARE DESIGNED TO SUPPLEMENT UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS AND NOT TO CREATE NEW JOBS.

IN THE SECOND PLACE, WE BELIEVE THAT THE MEASURES REGARDING WAGES ARE GOING TO CAUSE A DRASTIC FALL IN THE PURCHASING POWER OF WAGES, WE CANNOT AGREE WITH THIS, BECAUSE THE GOVERNMENT FORECASTS THAT PRICES WILL RISE BY OVER 30 PERCENT; IT WANTS US TO LIMIT WAGE INCREASES TO 20 PERCENT.

FURTHERMORE, WE BELIEVE THAT THERE IS A VERY SERIOUS ((CLAUSE)) WHICH THREATENS THE SECURITY OF EMPLOYMENT; THIS IS THE AGREEMENT THAT IF WORKERS IN A COMPANY MANAGE TO GET A WAGE INCREASE OVER AND ABOVE THE LIMIT, THAT COMPANY IS AUTHORIZED TO REDUCE ITS WORK FORCE BY 5 PERCENT. THIS, WE BELIEVE,

FOR THIS REASON THE WHICH UNDERSTANDS THAT EXISTING SITUATION IS VERY SERIOUS, HAS CALLED ON ALL TRADE UNIONS TO STAND UNITED BECAUSE WE BELIEVE THAT A COMMON STANCE BY ALL TRADE UNIONS IS NECESSARY SO THAT WE CAN OFFER THE GOVERNMENT A SERIES OF VITAL MEASURES TO OVERCOME THIS CRISIS SITUATION.

FOR THIS SAME REASON, THE SU IS GOING TO ASK THE POLITICAL PARTIES TO GIVE A DETAILED EXPLANATION OF THE AGREEMENT AND TO EXPLAIN THEIR MOTIVES FOR AGREEING TO THIS PROGRAM. WE ARE GOING TO TELL THE WORKERS THAT THEY SHOULD MOBILIZE THEMSELVES, ORGANIZE MEETINGS AND DISCUSS THIS PROGRAM--KNOWN AS THE MONCLOA PACT--AND ASK ALL DEPUTIES NOT TO VOTE FOR THIS PROGRAM IN THE CORTES BECAUSE TO APPROVE IT WOULD BE TO UNDERMINE THE MOST VITAL RIGHTS OF WORKERS, SUCH AS THE RIGHT TO A JOB, WE DO NOT WANT A WAGE FREEZE BECAUSE THIS IS SOMETHING WE HAVE SUFFERED WITH FOR 40 YEARS. WE BELIEVE THAT A WAGE FREEZE IS UNNECESSARY AND THAT IT IS POSSIBLE TO OVERCOME THE CRISIS WITHOUT A WAGE FREEZE.

((ANNOUNCER)) I THINK THAT THE POSITION OF THE TRADE UNIONS IS BRIEFLY SUMMED UP IN THIS STATEMENT, BUT WE MUST CONTINUE

THE WORKERS GENERAL UNION HAS DECIDED NOT TO MAKE A STATEMENT ON THIS SUBJECT AND IS AWAITING FURTHER DETAILS AND OFFICIAL STATEMENTS ON THE MONCLOA PACT, IT WILL NOT MAKE ANY STATEMENT UNTIL ITS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETS, ((PASSAGE OMITTED))

THE WORKERS COMMISSION HAS CONVENED AN EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF ITS CONFEDERAL SECRETARIAT FOR 11 OCTOBER, IN THE MEANTIME, MARCELINO CAMACHO, SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE WORKERS COMMISSIONS, HAS EXPRESSED OPTIMISM ABOUT THE FACT THAT TALKS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT AND THE POLITICAL PARTIES, BUT HE ALSO STRESSED THAT ANY AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THESE FORCES WILL NOT WIN THE SUPPORT OF THE TRADE UNIONS WHEN THE LATTER ARE LEFT OUT OF THE NEGOTIATIONS.
