ARMY TELEVISION SERVICE CHANNEL 5 IN THAI" AND "BANGKOK ARMY TELEVISION SERVICE CHANNEL 7 IN THAI" RESPECTIVELY. WHEN BOTH STATIONS COME ON AIR, THEY DISPLAY COLOR CHART WITH WORDS "ARMY TELEVISION, CHANNEL 5/7" (IN ENGLISH). THE FACT THAT THESE ARE MILITARY CHANNELS IS SUBSTANTIVELY STRATEGIC TO THE SELECTION OF THE ITEM -- MILITARY COVERAGE IS BEING COMPARED WITH CIVILIAN GOVERNMENT COVERAGE -- AND ARMY CONNECTION WILL HAVE TO BE MADE IN PROSLUG IN EACH CASE IF NOT CLEARLY STATED IN SOURCELINE, WHICH WE BELIEVE IS PREFERABLE. PRECEDENT IS AT HAND, AS RADIO HAS ALREADY BEEN DIFFERENTIATED BETWEEN BANGKOK DOMESTIC SERVICE AND BANGKOK 1ST ARMY DIVISION RADIO. 26/0052Z NOV
