1. PURPOSE: The purpose of this Bulletin is to announce a change in wage rates made under authority conferred upon the Director by the Department of the Treasury.



Definition:

Siderographer - Art of engraving steel; esp, a process of multiplying facsimiles of an engraved steel plate by rolling over it, when hardened, a soft, steel cylinder, and then rolling the cylinder when hardened, over a soft steel plate
