WAGE ADJUSTMENT

Effective Date: February 01, 1984

1. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this Bulletin is to announce changes in wage rates made under authority conferred upon the Director by the Department of the Treasury. In compliance with the Administration's request for a consistent pay policy in fiscal year 1984, the following wage adjustment reflects the 3.5 per cent ceiling imposed during this fiscal year.
2. **SCOPE.** This adjustment will affect approximately 25 employees in job classifications related to the Engraver, Sculptural Engraver, and Designer Crafts as listed on the following schedule.
3. **SUPERSESSION.** This wage adjustment supersedes BEP Bulletin No. 83-88, dated September 27, 1983.


