

Subject: Wage Change - Journeyman Bindery Workers

1. Purpose. This Notice promulgates a wage change for the subject employees.
2. Supersedure. This Notice supersedes GPO Notice 640-119, Subject: Wage Change - Journeyman Bindery Workers, dated October 7, 1982.
3. New Hourly Rates. As a result of a wage conference, the following schedule of new rates was approved by the Joint Committee on Printing on September 23, 1982, to be effective December 18, 1982.

4	10.07
5	10.60

4. Adjustments. All hourly wage rates will be adjusted to the nearest cent, counting one-half cent and over as a whole cent.
5. Cancellation. This Notice is canceled on June 18, 1983.
