No special coverage was requested during the reporting period.

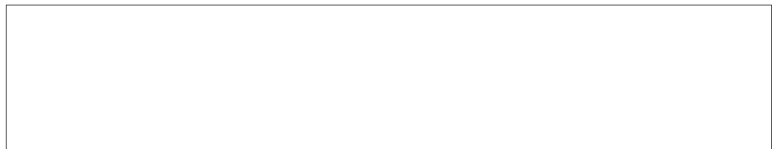
e. In response to these reconnaissance requirements, at least two flights per week will be conducted to insure the collection of information through stimulation of air defense reaction.
