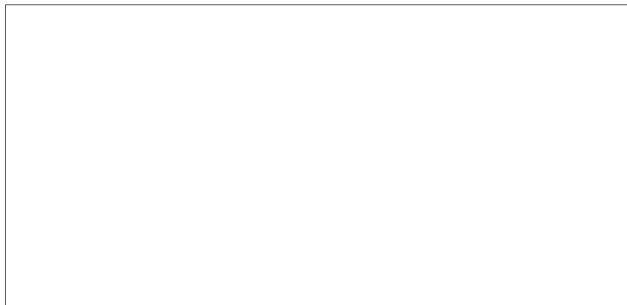

1. The Ad Hoc Requirements Committee tentatively agreed that the [redacted] should be placed on the highest priority list. Targets Related to Launch of Guided Missiles

2. In addition to the papers to be prepared as listed in the last Minute (ARC-M-69, [redacted] paragraphs j and k), the Army has agreed to prepare a study comparable to the aforementioned dealing with launch sites for IRBM, this to be available by 15 January 1958 along with the other papers.
