**Exhibit Tour of Europe**

1. The Chairman stated that General Cabell had requested that he query the Ad Hoc Requirements Committee further on the importance which they attach to the proposed tour which Mr. Lundahl might take to brief the top people in the European theatre commands. All participants felt that this tour should go forward although the Air Force felt that it would be best if this were delayed until some future time. The Air Force, however, indicated that in the event the tour took place they would be willing to cooperate in making arrangements and would wish to send a representative along. The Chairman indicated that the Agency would wish such a representative from the Air Force and also from the Army and Navy if feasible.
