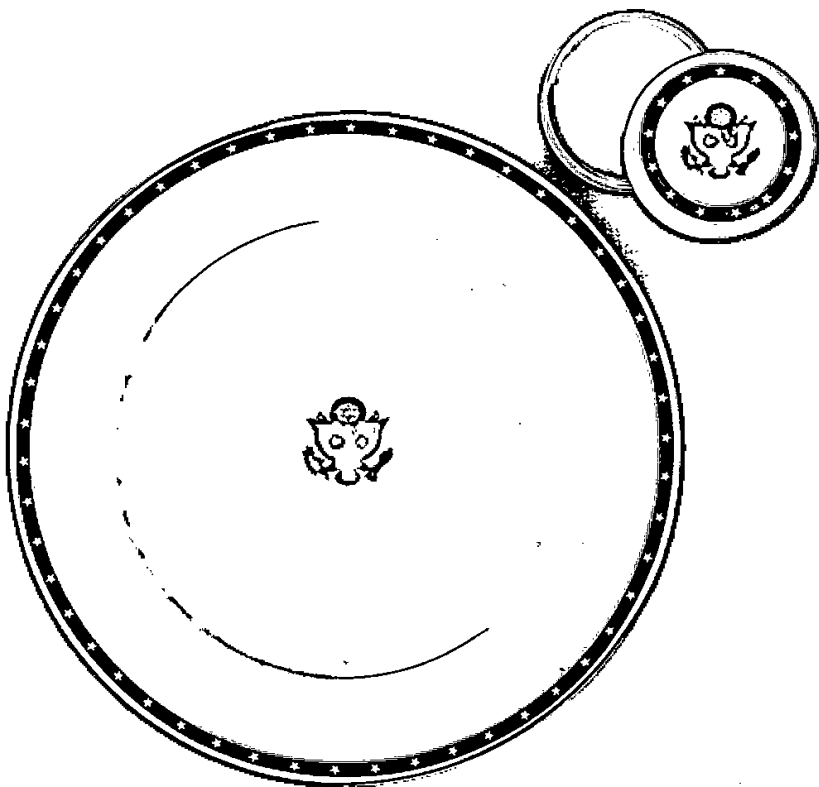

A gift selected from this catalogue will prolong the remembrance of these historic events.



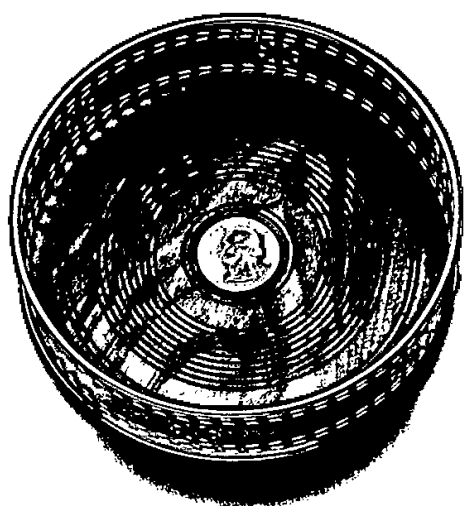


Lenox Bicentennial Inaugural Plate and Box

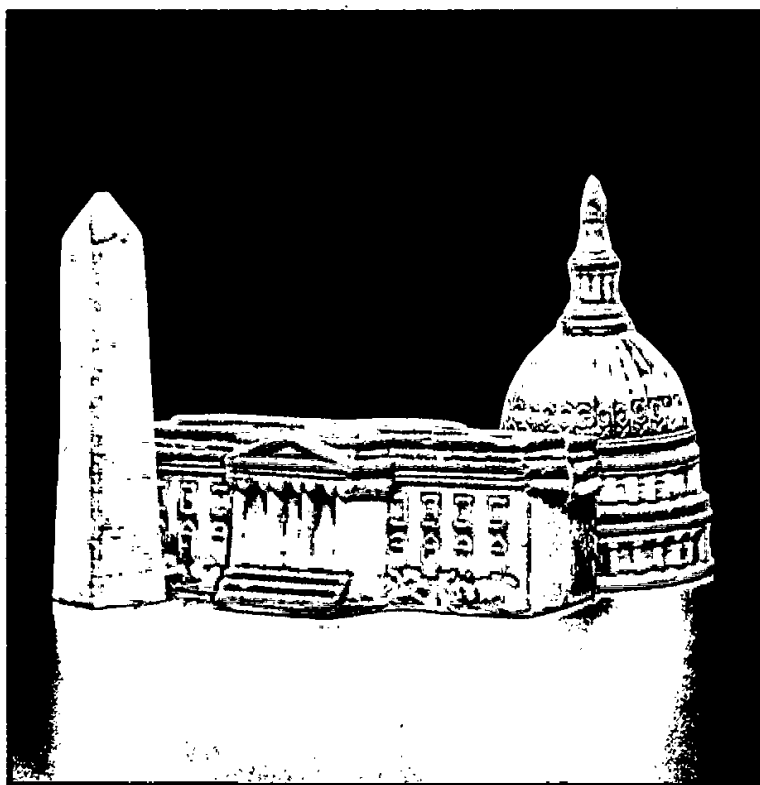

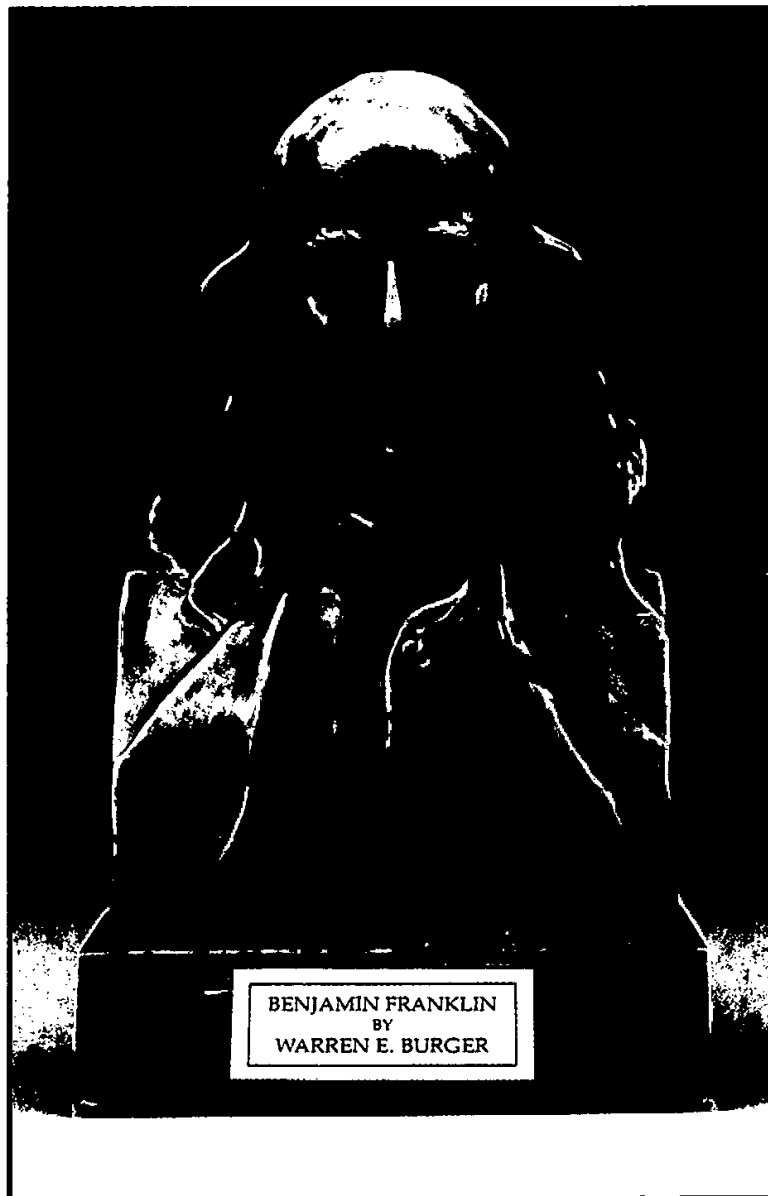

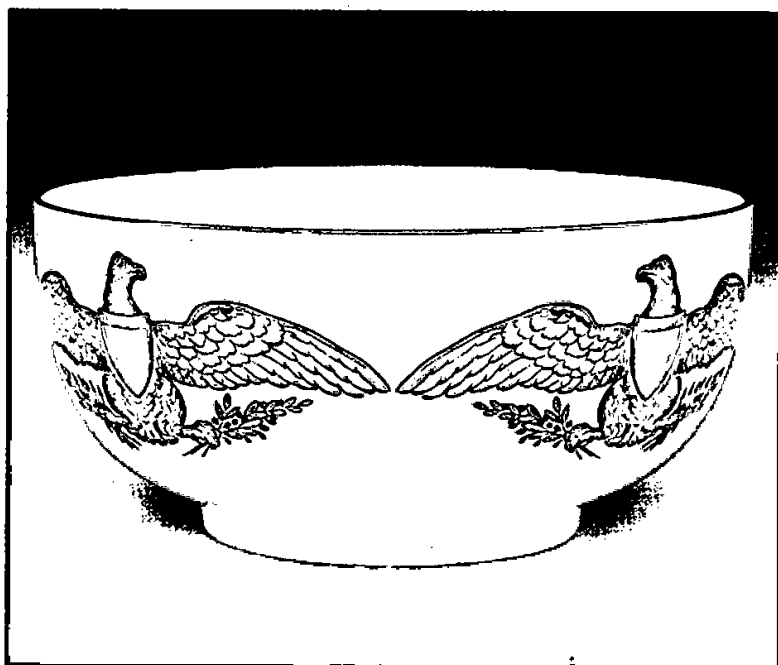

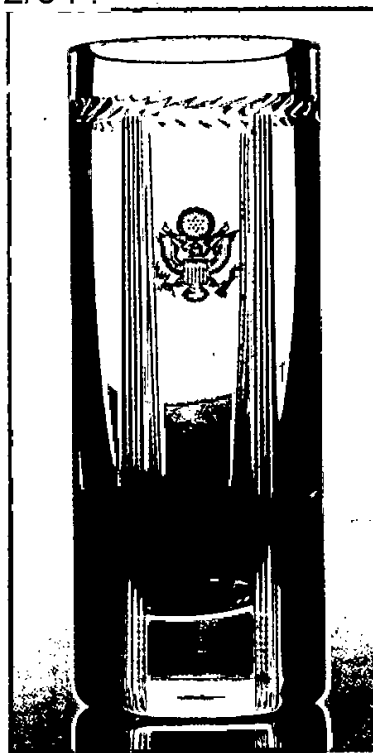

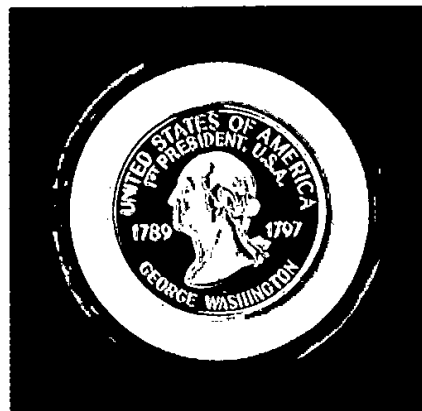

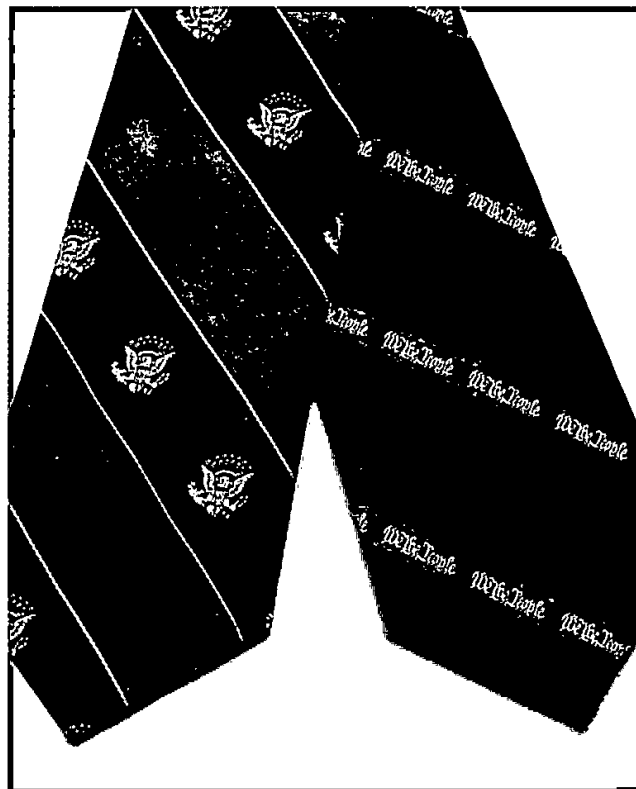
