SUBJECT: Certification of the Need for Extension
of Classification on Documents Systematically
Reviewed and Processed During the Year 1980

REFERENCE: Memorandum of 24 April 1981 to Director of
Central Intelligence from Max Hugel, Deputy
Director for Administration

1. In referenced memorandum requesting certification for the years 1978 and 1979, Mr. Hugel described the manner in which systematic review is conducted, the experience level of the officers conducting the review, and the types of information we are protecting under Executive Order 12065. He further explained that Classification Review Division's recommendations are recorded in an ADP system called Declassification and Review (DARE), which is also designed to be your record of those documents you have certified as requiring continued classification to protect national security interests. Only the head of an agency may make such a certification, and you certified the extension of classification for the years 1978 and 1979 on 29 April 1981.

2. We are now requesting your certification for entries to the DARE system during the year 1980. During that year [] documents were reviewed. Of these, Classification Review Division recommends continued classification of [] to protect the following:

- Sources and Methods
- Foreign Government Information
- Foreign Relations
- Cryptology
- Other



The remaining [] documents are being protected at the CONFIDENTIAL level pending coordination with other agencies. As before, we are attaching a random sampling of these documents for your perusal.

3. It is recommended that you certify the need for classification extension by signing the attached certificate.


