Amount of Data Input Limited

Store Only Data of Questionable Classifiability

Data Will be Stored Verbatim

Indexing Will Provide Precise Input and Recall

Data Can Be Extensively Manipulated

DATA WILL BE STORED VERBATIM

INDEXING WILL PROVIDE PRECISE INPUT AND RECALL
