6. In general the USSR has demonstrated an electronics capability in excess of that estimated. For example, in 1950-51, while US and British intelligence were debating the ability of the USSR to produce a copy of the SCR-584 fire control radar (given to the USSR in lend lease), the USSR was producing them in quantity. Further, the appearance in operational use of Soviet ground control intercept radar similar to the US ANE/CPS-6 (no copy of which was obtained by the USSR), was a distinct surprise.

7. In citing these examples, no attempt has been made to indicate general trends of over or under-estimation during the 1948-1953 period inasmuch as that would require a comprehensive survey.
