1. sinitsin video report on responses of soviet working people to recent cpsu central committee plenum and supreme soviet sessions; shots of red square and interviews with a number of delegates to the supreme soviet who comment on the significance of andropov's and gromyko's addresses. (2.5 min)

2. tikhomirov video report on moscow atomteploelectroproekt insitute designing a new atomic hydrothermal power station; shots of diagrams, reactor and interview with the institute director, draftsmen at work; economic advantages of the new reactor are discussed at length. (3 min)

3. report on harvest in progress in uzbekistan and plotnikov video report on the beginning of winter crop harvesting in simferopol oblast using the ipatov method to complete harvesting ahead of schedule; shots of grain combines and other agricultural machinery. (1.5 min)

4. chernyak video report on new motor vessel designed especially

for vegetable transportation and operated by volzhskiy shipping association; shots of the vessel. (1 min)

5. pavlov video report on kishinev carpet combine in moldavia producing 25 percent more carpets than planned because of increased productivity; shots of the combine and an interview with its director; shots of other consumer goods produced by the combine. (1.5 min)

6. report on congratulatory telegrams to andropov in connection with his election to the post of chairman of ussr supreme soviet presidium; telegrams from le duan and other vietnamese leaders, honecker, tsedenbal, ceausescu, kim il-song, npc, queen elizabeth, mitterrand, carstens and other party and government statesmen of the world cited. (und min)

7. tass report on world response to results of the cpsu central committee plenum and ussr supreme soviet sessions citing czechoslovak press, uk morning star, u.s. tribune, japanese press and other world press commenting on significance of both events. (1.5 min)

8. shishkovskiy video report on the opening of the meeting of the international physicians for the prevention of a nuclear war organization in amsterdam; shots of delegates arriving for the session, opening including academician Chazov who conveys andropov's greetings to the congress. (1.5 min)

9. report over video on opening of fdj congress in berlin citing the issues covered at the congress; shots of the congress and speakers. (und min)

10. tass report on nicaraguan foreign minister's statement condemning u.s. support for armed aggression against nicaragua from honduras. (und min)

11 glazunov video report on frg press and public expressing

concern over the approaching deadline for the deployment of u. s. missiles in frg citing debates in bundestag and reagan's new policy on missile deployment in western europe; shots of bundestag in session. (2 min)

12. uk ambassador extraordinary and plenipotentiary to the ussr's video address in connection with uk national day. the ambassador speaks in russian on common views between british and soviet people despite political and social differences, and on the recent uk elections emphasizing the democratic nature of these elections. he then dwells on uk foreign policy. (4 min)

13. report over video on u. s. testing new mx missiles which are launched from california and strike targets in the pacific ocean; shots of the launching. (und min)

14. political observer eduard mnatsakakov video commentary on ussr proposals to freeze nuclear arms citing appeal to u. s., uk, french and prc governments to simultaneously freeze the nuclear arsenal at the current quantitative and qulalitative level. (the address ends in progress; logo appears on the screen intermittently with the program remaining off the air for approximately 5 minutes and resuming with item 15.)

15 tereshkina video report on georgian cultural organization arriving in moscow to mark 200th anniversary of the signing of the russian-georgian friendship treaty; shots of delegates in moscow airport and interview with an artist. (1.5 min)

16. sports. (3.5 min)

17. weather. 181700

note: a check of the moscow domestic television russian 182200 vremya indicates that it is identical to the items listed for the 181700 vremya. the 182200 also gives the remainder of the address interrupted

2. report over video on npc plenary session where li xiannian is elected as chairman of prc; other appointments cited; shots of the session. (und min)

3. tass report on u. s. launching multiple use spaceship with five astronauts including the first american female astronaut. (und min)
