1. camera shows zorin saying that teletype reports show that washington is increasing tension in central america and that nicaragua is the main target of u.s. special services; nicaraguan defense ministry reports about new anti-nicaraguan provocation, with video showing fire at fuel depot at corinto port (proc) 037

2. zorin speaks about the failure of the washington propaganda operation to seize political and diplomatic initiative at the un session, and about reagan hoping that his speech at the un session would give the tone for the work of the un general assembly session, zorin speaks about reagan's initiatives being met at the un session as a propaganda move, with video showing delegates at the session. he then speaks about soviet proposals outlined in gromyko's letters to the un secretary general. speaking about the support for the nuclear freeze resolution in the world, zorin says that a nuclear freeze resolution has been moved even in the u.s. congress. 4. zorin says that international news agencies present as a great sensation reagan's statement about his wanting to hold soviet-u. s. talks at the highest level. after referring to another reagan statement about soviet-u. s. relations in which he said that they are not at a low point, zorin refers to another statement by Reagan a few weeks ago in which he said that he thought that it is not possible to conduct any kind of business with the russians. he then comments on the reasons for the change.
