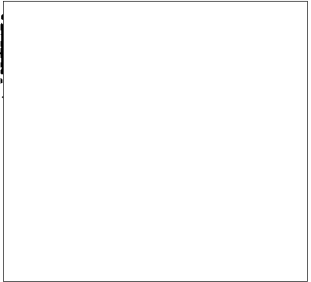

SUBJECT: Computer Terminal Installation Problems

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1. As you probably know, this Directorate has been experiencing some particularly distressing problems concerning the acquisition and installation of computer terminals. I am told that there is currently a backlog of over [ ] DO requests outstanding, some of which date back more than a year. Furthermore, I understand that the Directorate of Operations is currently slated to receive no computer terminals in FY 1982 in spite of the fact that [ ] terminals are to be acquired and installed elsewhere throughout Headquarters by the Office of Data Processing.

2. I am aware of some of the problems facing the DDA concerning terminal installations and realize that you have a program underway to obtain some relief. The dimensions of the problem are becoming so staggering, however, that I fear they, combined with the continuing new terminal demand, may outstrip your ability to catch up anytime soon. If there is anything we in the DO can do to help alleviate this problem, please let me know.

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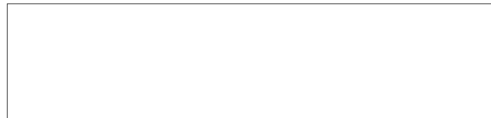

3. Regarding the problem of terminal allocations, I am, quite frankly, surprised to learn that the DO is not slated to receive any of the [ ] terminals authorized in the FY 1982 ODP budget. My staff informs me that in February 1980 we projected to ODP a requirement for [ ] terminals during this period. While it is understandable that ODP could not fully support a request for 81 terminals for the DO when it can purchase only [ ] for the entire Headquarters, it is dismaying that the DO is to receive none of the [ ]. Some proportionate distribution of the 66 across all Directorates would seem to be a more equitable arrangement.
