Target was the third on the list provided telephonically.

Geo coordinates were:

Following is gist of the description provided:

- a. A column of fire going straight up.
- b. A desolate, but rolling area with the ground opening into a mound.
- c. Several large holes over a wide area, four or five.
- d. Slight border of green on the left.
- e. A metal domed shape like an old hangar, made of metal.
- f. Approximately four very heavy fork lift type vehicles working inside the hangar-type building.
- g. Looked like a big storage area for huge pipes 3'-4' in diameter.
- h. Feeling that what was being looked for was already gone.

Directed= to go back in time and look for that which was being sought.

- a. A rocket vehicle of some sort, poised to take off, in the ground.
- b. Time of acquisition of target: approximately 12 days prior to 09 October 1980.

Directed to return to the warehouse/hangar type building and present time.

- a. Same large cylinders, feeling of maintenance.
- b. Move to 12 Oct 80 large cylinder gone.
- c. 15 Oct working on something smaller.
