STRUCK ME AS VERY STRANGE THAT THE

ALONG THE RAIL FACING INTO THE
 ALCOVE, AWAY FROM THE VERY SCENIC VIEW.
 THE "SCENIC VIEW" WAS SURPRISING IN ITS
 A1, AS WELL. THE TUBULAR AREA WAS SO
 LARGE THAT, LOOKING ACROSS IT, YOU COULD
 SEE THE HAZE IN THE AIR.
