SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

Thomas Sutherland is currently "isolated" and located in the area known as "Anqun" which is located less than five miles southeast of Sidon. See ENCLOSURE 1.

The name "Fromters/Frothers" and variations thereto phonetically surfaced as the name of a person currently involved in current negotiations related to the release of hostages, particularly that of Edward Tracy and Frank Reed. The name "Werner/Warner" resurfaced and described as an "arbitrator" in the negotiation process.

In the order of releasability, USMC LTC Higgins and Thomas Sutherland appeared projected as the first hostages to be released from captivity. Terry Anderson remains projected as the last hostage to be released from captivity.

1. (S/NF/SK) MISSION: To confirm or disprove the releasability of two hostages before Christmas as reported by the news media; one of the hostages tentatively identified as Terry Anderson.
2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: Viewer 079 tasked with requirements reflected in Para 1, above.
3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: No inclemencies noted. Viewer appeared belaboring under what was considered a "too much info break." 079 perceived that too many events/influences were occurring at the current time affecting the release of the hostages. Viewer 079 appeared confused and developed a headache at the end or as a result of the session. A Summary of Information is attached to this report.
