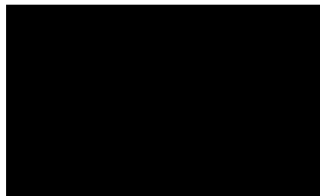

2. (S/NF/SK) Cuing: 6-digit encrypted coordinates: 696910/136160.

3. (S/NF/SK) Tasking: Access and describe Area A.

4. (S/NF/SK) Results:

a. The general site appears to be a complex of identical structures (see sketch, page 2).

b. The interior of (a) structure is large (a single, multi-storied room) in which there is a lot of noisy activity. The activity and associated objects, however, are small in relation to the room, and are all at floor level. (see sketch, page 3).

c. The activity involves people and boxes. It appears that they are either putting things into the boxes or taking them out (direction of activity not yet determined).

d. Accessing a single person, I found a person standing at a table on which sat a cardboard box. The person had his hands on an object in the box. Behind him was a low row of rollers, on which "handlable-sized" objects of various shapes lay (see sketch, page 4).

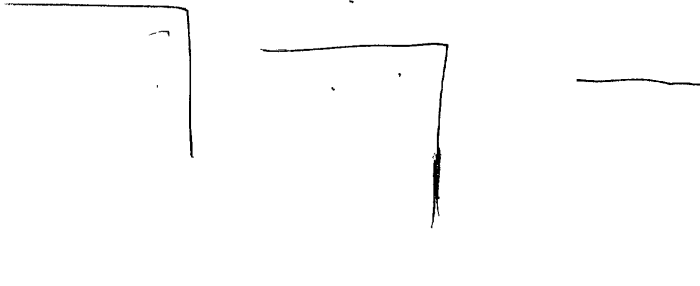

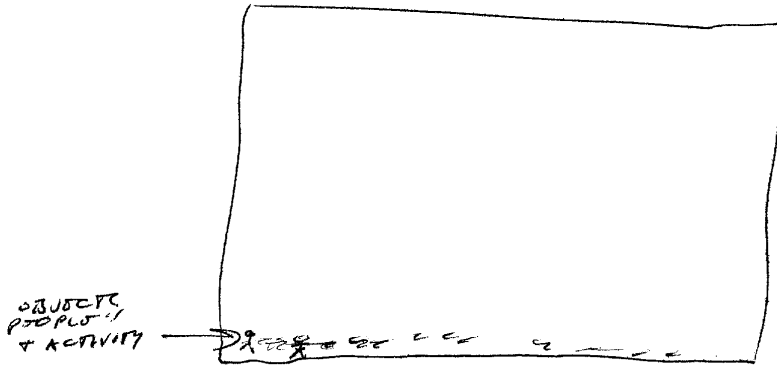
