SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The current locatio of the [redacted] is indicated at ENCLOSURE 1. Sailing time for the [redacted] from Aruba to Andros (ENCLOSURE 2) where the drugs will be unloaded, is from five to seven days.

The vessel will then continue to its "plausible" port of call indicated as Daytona Beach, Florida. The vessel is then described as leaving from Daytona Beach, "turning around and going home (Columbia?). The drug shipment is considered a large shipment. It is stowed in white boxes having some sort of sliver lining. The boxes are stowed in a mixed cargo area.

Additional data that was undecipherable dealt with information describing the drugs as being in pellet form (?); possibly the white boxes were stored on "pallets"; and piety (objects of piety-statues) appeared involved.
