SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

There are metallic containers on board the [redacted] which are indented on top and shiny on the sides (see sketch on pages 3 and 4). This ship has paneled board siding. In a deep dark area (cellar) there are little containers. The [redacted] has drugs which are stored in containers for preservation purposes. These containers have separate caps which open at the top (see sketch on page 5). The cocaine is stored in the center of the ship and was lowered down and under (sketches are on pages 6A and 6B).

Two other ships are involved ^{as} "Scouts" which are located in the outlying water area, far enough away from the direct exchange of drugs. These vessels are aware of the activities but cannot be seen in the immediate vicinity from where the drugs are unloaded. The [redacted] will unload the drugs to one scheduled vessel. A name is cam, Camy, or Camry (see sketch on page 9).

The [redacted] is also involved, but not directly with unloading the drugs. This ship is suspicious because it is grand and a home connection. original vessels in the preliminary proceedings of the drug deal.

In conclusion, there are not two ships for the unloading of the drugs, only one, and there are "Scouts" for when the drug exchange occurs. An area of concern is Yakutat Bay, Alaska and the exchange will happen around the border of Canada and the U.S., near the bay area of Portsmouth, not further than Halifax (45 N/70 W).

1. (S/NF/SK) The contraband aboard the [redacted] was lowered down and under into a deep, dark area (see enclosure 1) in the center of the ship (see enclosures 2 & 3). For preservation purposes, it is stored in metallic "canisters" (see enclosure 4) which are indented on top and shiny on the sides (see enclosure 5). These containers have separate caps which open at the top.

2. (S/NF/SK) The other ships involved in the offloading of the contraband are:

a) Two which act as "scouts", staying far enough away from the actual transfer point as to not be visible on the horizon (see enclosure 6).

b) A single vessel to which the contraband will be unloaded from the [redacted] (see also enclosure 6). This vessel is named [estimate: Cam, Camy, or Camry]

c) The [redacted] is also involved, but not directly with unloading the drugs. This ship is suspicious because it is grand and a home connection. Although it is suspected, the outcome will be unexpected, because it will not be the vessel with the cocaine on it in the long run. The [redacted] is one of the original vessels in the preliminary proceedings of the drug deal.

3. The final destination of the [redacted] was not addressed in this session.

4. The immediate destination of the ship onto which the contraband will be off-loaded [Cam, Camy, Camry] appears to be a "white-water" area in the Bay of Alaska, at Yakutat Bay, Alaska (see point A, enclosure 7).

The final destination of the contraband, itself, was addressed, giving impressions of Yakutat Bay, Alaska, then of an exchange which will happen around the border of Canada and the U.S., near the bay area around Portsmouth (see point B, enclosure 7), not further north than Halifax (45 degrees N/ 70 degrees W).

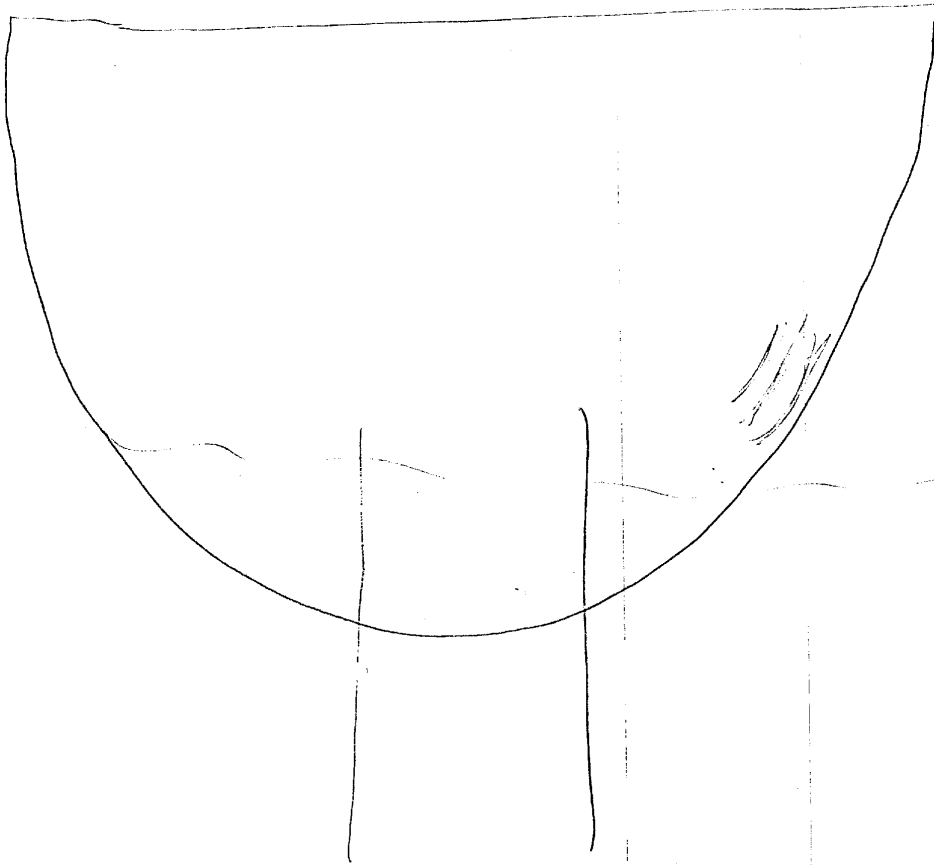

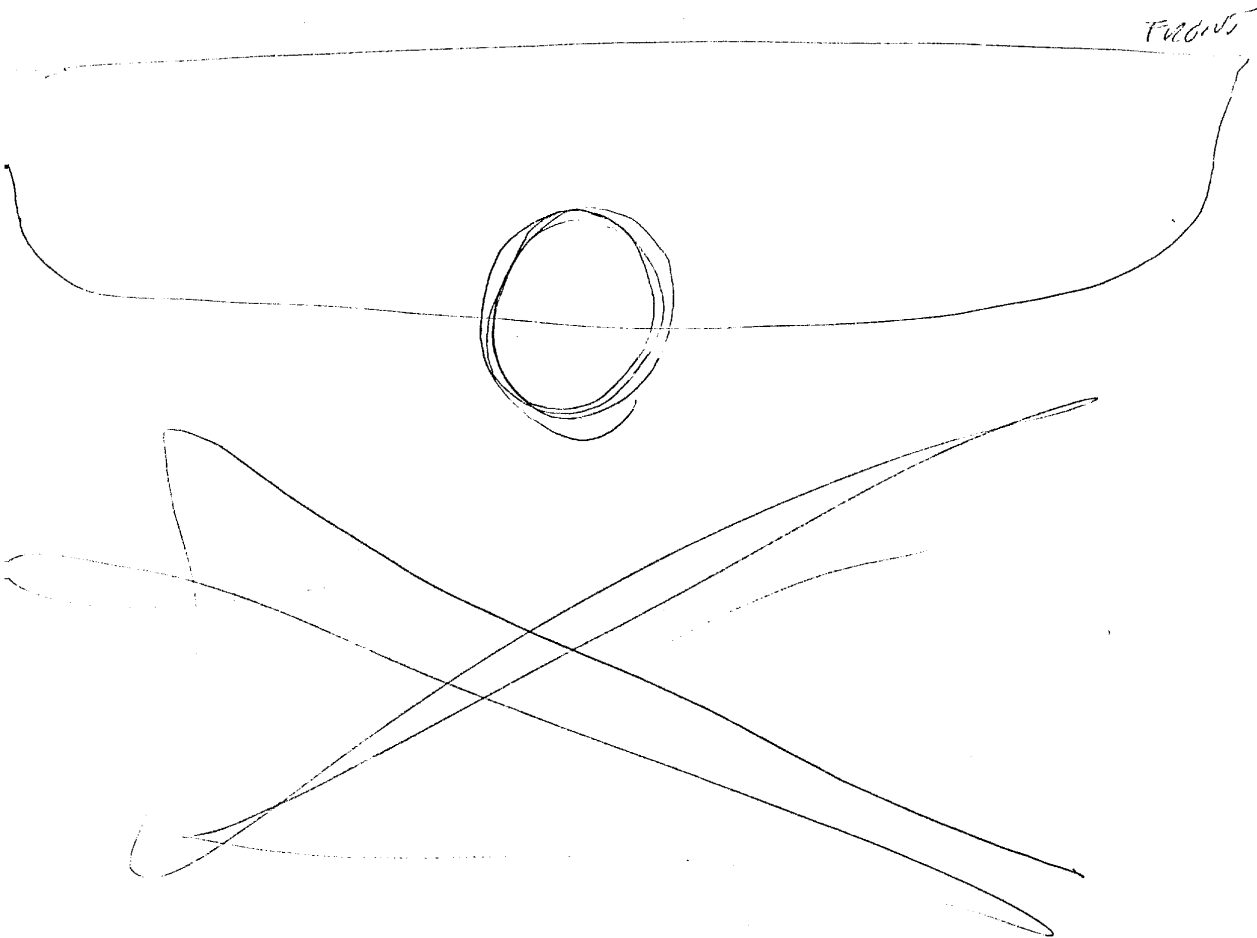
LOOKING AT FRONT OF SHIP
