THE TRANSFER OF CONTRABAND TAKES PLACE IN OPEN WATER, BEYOND A REEF, NEAR AN ISLAND. THE DEPTH OF WATER AT THIS LOCATION IS APPROXIMATELY 30-40 FEET (SEE SKETCH, PAGE 2). THIS ISLAND IS PART OF A CHAIN OF ISLANDS SITUATED IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN, SOMEWHERE SOUTH AND WEST OF THE UNITED STATES (SEE SKETCH, PAGE 3). THE CONTRABAND IS INTENDED TO BE OFF-LOADED ONTO, AT LEAST, TWO SMALLER VESSELS. THESE SMALLER VESSELS WOULD THEN PROCEED TO THE NEARBY ISLAND WHERE THERE IS A BASE OF OPERATIONS AND AN OLD AIRSTRIP (SEE SKETCH, PAGE 2). 


