## Summary of information

EEI#1:

SG1A

The current location (1415L 06 Jul 90) of  is 11° 32' N 46° 21' W.

EEI#2:

The cargo consists of hashish or what is colloquially called "hash oil"; more confident with the former. It is wrapped in blue, green & yellowish ~~xxxx~~ woven wrapping. I feel there are different "types" or "kinds" of this (if that's possible?). The packages look similar to a large book, ~~and are fairly packed~~ ~~fast fairly densely~~. The contents is very hard and very dense. There is an imprint, stamp or printing either on the wrapping or on the material itself (see diagram page 5).

Location of on vessel is confusing because of the sense that there is a tremendous amount of contraband on board. I just get the feeling that the vessel is packed to the "max" with very little spare space for the crew. There is really no space allocated for even sleeping or eating.

There is a recessed central area covered with a wooden plank door or lid. Nuclear if this is significant.
