SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The vessel is currently (18 1200L May 90) located northwest of the Antilles at 67 21 N 12 33 W heading due NE.

The vessel is currently carrying contraband in the form of 5-6 kilograms of cocaine. The cocaine is located at midships just to the portside of the center of the vessel at the waterline. The cocaine has been molded into something brown, smooth and plastic. There was the impression that because of this it could not be smelled by dogs. To get the cocaine out the brown thing has to be destroyed/broken.

The cocaine will be offloaded to another vessel on 21 (if not then 22) May 1990 between 1800-2000L (our time).

The ultimate destination of the contraband is the mideastern United States.

1. Determine the current location of the target vessel.

RESPONSE: The vessel is currently located (18 MAY 90) AT 67° 21' N 12° 33' W heading NE. (North ^{east} of the Antilles)

2. Determine if the vessel is currently carrying drugs; if so, where stored on ship.

RESPONSE: The vessel is currently carrying between 5-6 Kilograms of cocaine. It is located midships just to the port side of the center (C-D, 5-6 on national grid) ^{AT THE WATERLINE} The cocaine has been molded into something brown.

3. When and where the target vessel off-load / transfers the contraband

RESPONSE: The cocaine will be OFFLOADED TO ANOTHER VESSEL ON 21 1800-2000 MAY 90 AT A LOCATION SSE OF Nevis Island AT 17° N 62° 33' W

4. what is the ultimate destination of the contraband in the US

RESPONSE: MID-EASTERN STATES (will be transferred more than 3 times before then)
