SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

Vessel A has a tall head with a wheel in front and is cruising westward. Vessel B is long, has a guild, and is crest fallen with rust in poor condition. Women are aboard this vessel. Vessel B will take the cocaine and transfer it to Boat A at the red mark indicated on Map 1 near Indonesia. The transfer will occur within fourteen days. Vessel A will off load the narcotics at the red mark indicated on Map 2 near Alaska within a month and a half. The call signs associated with vessel A include: GS-SITS, TISTS, STTS, G 3EE, and 2 SFT. There are two sequences of letters and numbers (call signs) with this vessel.
