

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

Site is in an area that appears to be open and expansive -- almost desert like. There is a great deal of concrete present that places designs and patterns on the ground. There were objects that rise out of the ground (they may actually just be sitting on the ground) which are very high, A/S launch platforms for space ships. There were pipes, aluminum alloy devices that looked like flat hooks. There were sheets of aluminum alloy stretched over a frame of some sort.

I saw a bottle smash on something (see Figure 1) and when cued to explore it found that a woman had smashed it upon the surface of a large object (see Figure 2). This object has a dark almost black finish to it which gives it a dull rough finish. The object is a ship -- probably a submarine by the appearance of it. This ship carries large missiles on it that are concealed from view inside the hull. The only visible indications that this craft fires missiles are the openings placed evenly along the top of the ship's walkway or I guess you would call it a deck.

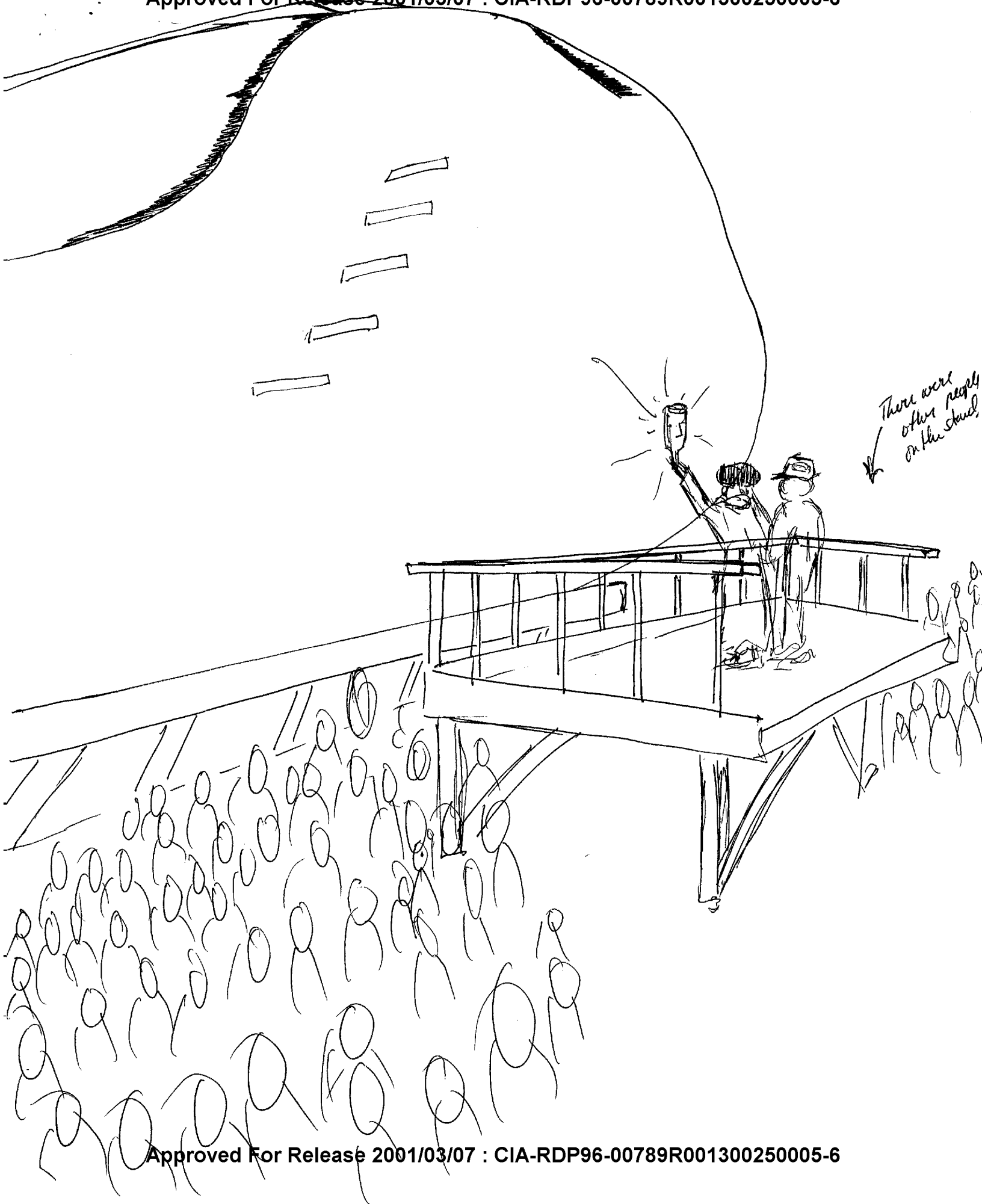

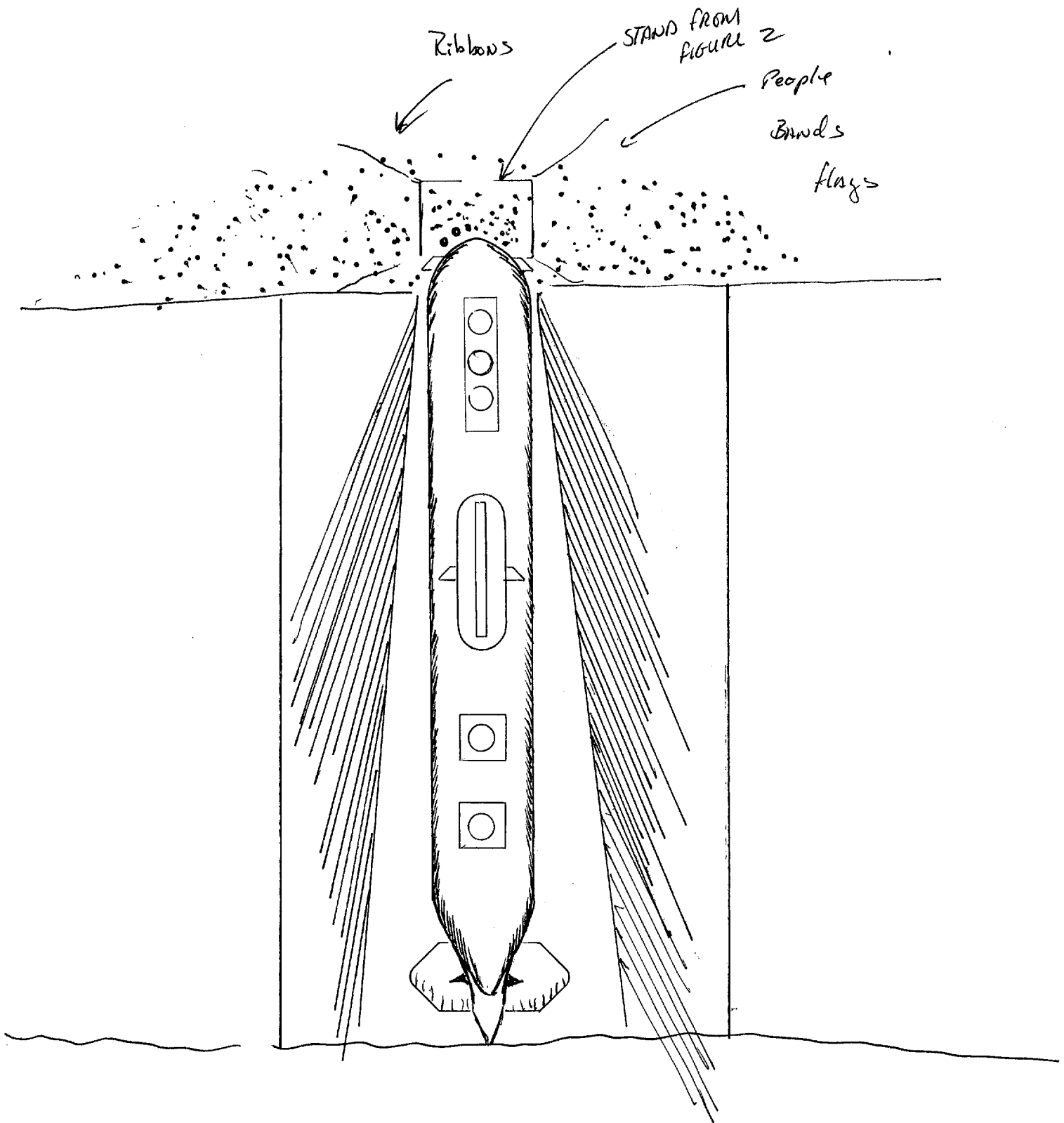
