SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The mother ship picked a "load of poppies" from a Caribbean country, either from Haiti or Jamaica, or both. It then proceeded to the Florida Keys where it met with the [REDACTED] SG1B
Laden with a capacity load, the [REDACTED] SG1B sailed north along the Atlantic coast.

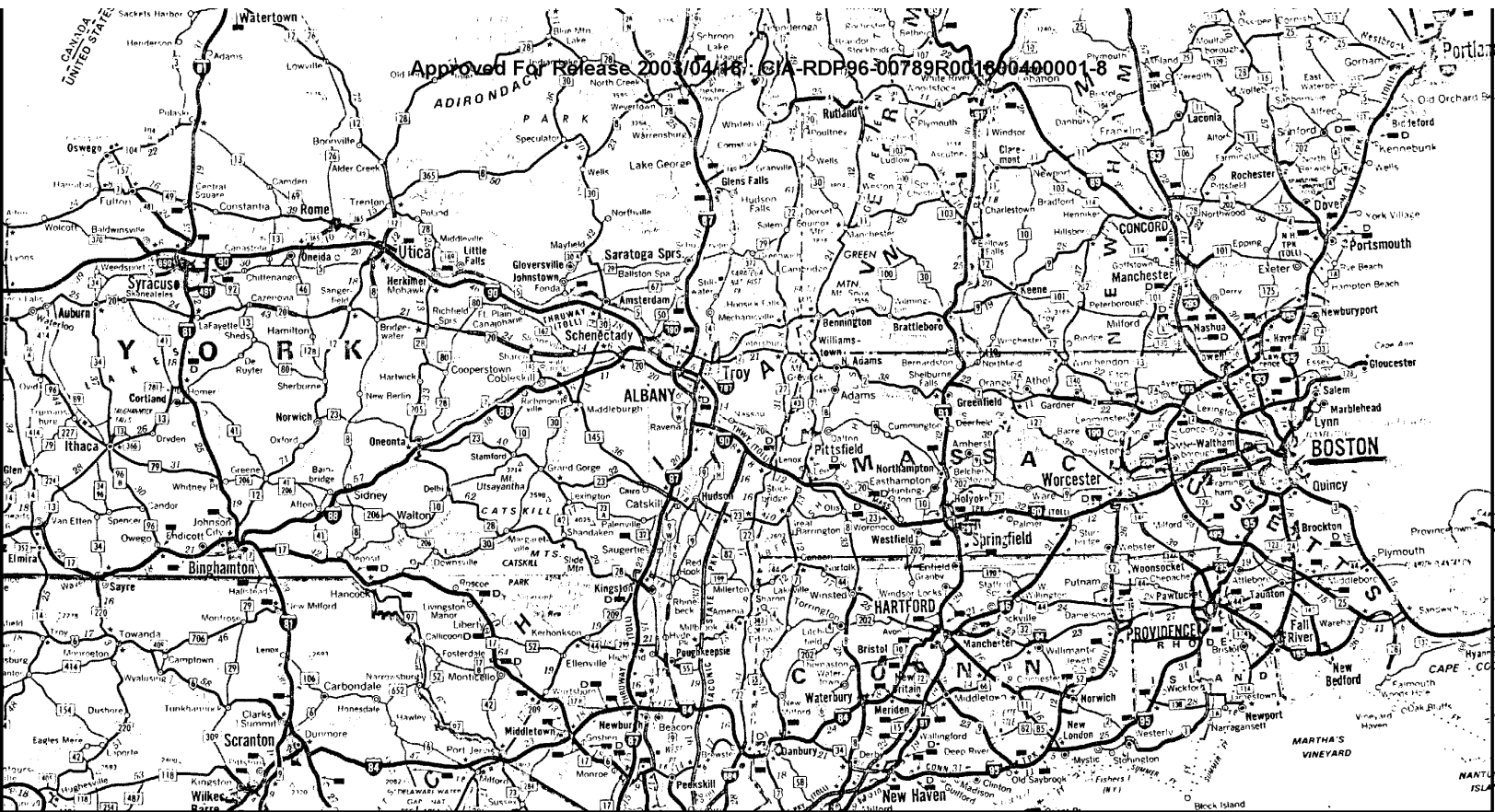

The current location of the [REDACTED] is indicated by the letter "X", ENCLOSURE 1. The [REDACTED] will make a refueling stop in a port area located in the immediate vicinity of Providence, R.I. It will subsequently resume its trek north following the Atlantic coastline and bound for Boston Harbor. It is anticipated to arrive during the evening hours of 3 October 1988.

Efforts to determine the identity of the mother ship resulted in the surfacing of the following phonetic expressions: "Rust-Cruz-Cummings." The mother ship was described as an old, rusty, somewhat rundown vessel with a faded white superstructure, black keel, and yellow/buff gangways.

Efforts to determine the mother ship's point of origin surfaced the concept of a "blockade warehouse." Further efforts to describe this expression were unsuccessful,
