- 2. (S-SS) Cuing: 6 digit encrypted coordinates: 179010/864892.
- 3. (S-SS) Tasking: Provide an overhead sketch of the target site. Describe the personality of specific interest.
- 4. (S-SS) Results:
- a. The target site consists of a semi-isolated, enclosed area which contains a large, squat, rectangular building which appears to have a flat roof. There is another structure adjacent to it which is tall and round. This structure appears to be closely related to the rectangular one, but not physically attached (see sketch, page 9 of the transcript). There is also an attached area which was not clearly distinguishable.
- b. The person of specific interest presents a constant puzzlement. He generates the impression that he can only be seen as a continuum, rather than as a present-time person. The impression of the earlier part of the continuum is of both a young woman and a young man. The impression of him at the latter end of the continuum is of an older, mildly heavyset man. Accessing him at this later time, there is a strong impression of a divided mind, almost to the point of two different personalities. This fact about the person may or may not be important to the "specific interest", but was a feature about him which grabbed my attention. Because of my focus of attention on this aspect of the man, It did not occur to me during the session that it might be more productive to concentrate attention on his relationship to and/or his part in the target activity.
