person is a bit of a zealot, + he's promoting some course of action that others see as rather perilous. He's a good salesman, though, + some fear he may persuade undecided ones to give him majority support. There is one overall key figure who carries most weight but whom those present regard as somewhat "out of it" - a bit arbitrary, who might be inclined to make last-second decisions because of a whim, but which would bind the others to support. The zealot person is honestly accepted by the overall person because the zealot person is a "young ho" "hard charger" whose goals + Weltanschauung are quite similar to the leader's, though the leader is, naturally, more than the zealot person can get carried away + be preposterous in his demands; still the leader is likely to listen to him because he likes what he says + because he often regards the others as worry-wart wafflers.

Perceived debate is about a course of action, including violent, military low-scale commitment - both directed against ~~external~~ external nation, but also with a potential for physical + diplomatic harm to their own interests. The cooler heads acknowledge that it could work, but that the potential damage might outweigh any good that might come of it. Still, they're intrigued, if cautious. On a continuum, they're a little right of center, the zealot way towards the left end. (He senses the need to be extreme to balance out the others).
