

Important foreign intelligence and counterintelligence purposes are served by GRILL FLAME experimentation. Informed consent of all subjects is obtained in writing and only in accordance with guidelines issued by Department of Health Education and Welfare setting conditions that safeguard the welfare of the subjects.
- 3. (S) Request the Under Secretary approve our participation in GRILL FLAME activities under Procedure 18.
