MEMORANDUM FOR DIRECTOR, DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY


SUBJECT: Request for the Establishment of a Special Access Program (U)

(U) This is in response to the 14 March 1985 memorandum (S-72/DT) from your Assistant Deputy Director for Scientific and Technical Intelligence wherein a request is made for the approval of a new Special Access Program.

(C-SK) The SUN STREAK (U) Special Access Program is approved effective on 30 March 1985. The codeword SKEET has been assigned to designate the particularly sensitive aspects of the information described in the referenced memorandum. The codeword is classified Confidential and may be disclosed only to those persons having access to SKEET information.

(U) As a matter of information, on 28 November 1984, the DUSD(P) issued a revised Chapter XII, DoD 5200.1-R, "Information Security Program Regulation" that modifies the procedures pertaining to Special Access Program approvals. A copy of the revised Chapter is attached; its provisions should be followed in future requests of this nature. In the event a nickname under this new system is desired, it is requested that your point of contact for the Program discuss the matter with Mr. Anthony G. Mitchell, my Deputy Director for Information Security and Special Programs. Mr. Mitchell may be reached on 694-0578.

(U) It is requested that a copy of the security classification guide and at least a summary statement of Program security requirements be provided to Mr. Mitchell.
