A record of topical searches will be made in the form of a listing with the date of search, the so-called forecast, and extent of ground truth known in real time. Topical searches resulting in high potential for real time occurrence will be pursued in detail as if they were actionable.

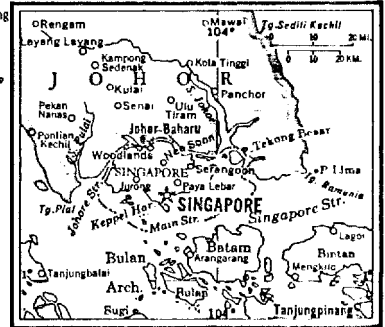
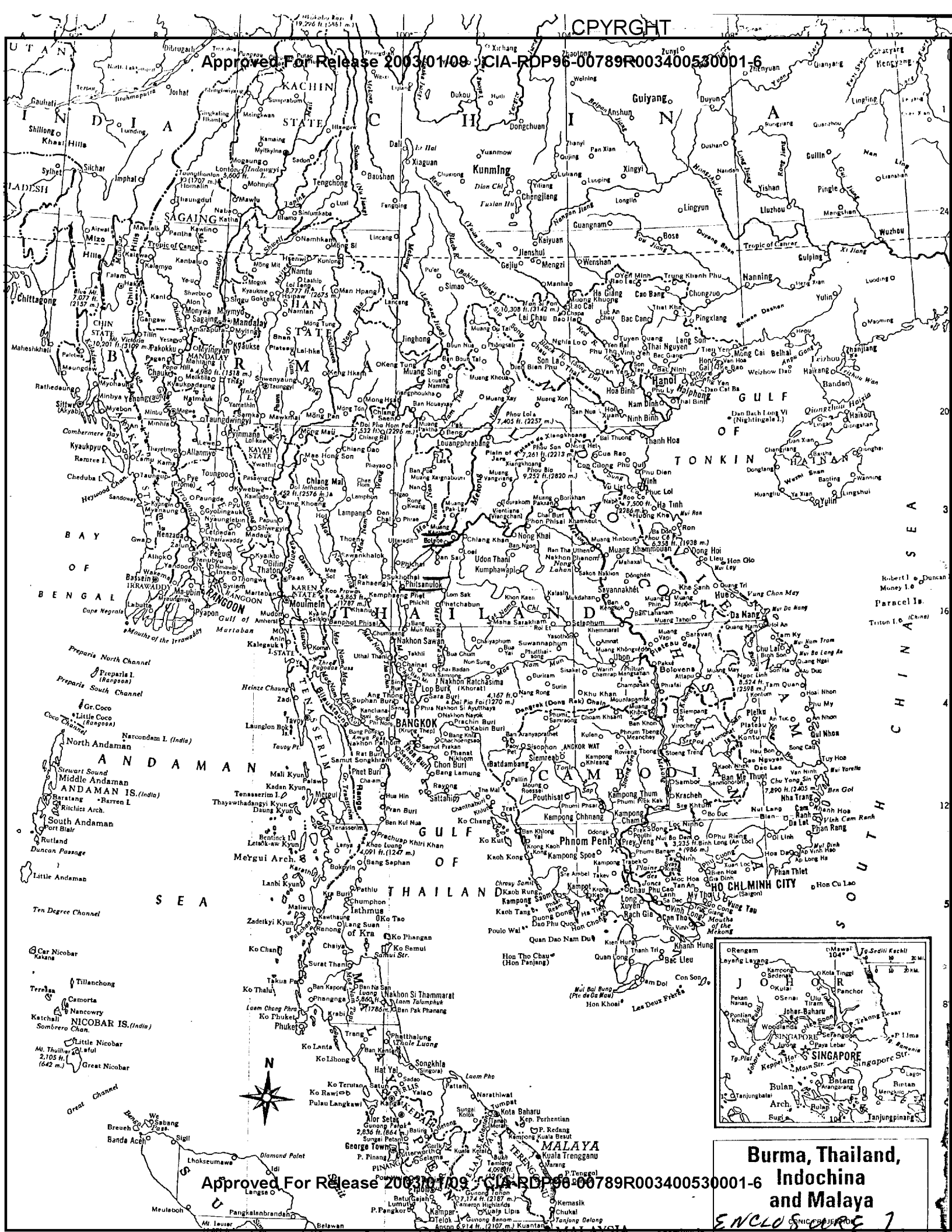
SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

There appears a high likelihood for an incursion of Thailand by a Laotian force of about 500 personnel during the time frame estimated as ranging from 30 October 1988 to 3 November 1988. The area of incursion is described as an area marked by Botene, Laos, and Phitsanulok, Thailand. See ENCLOSURE 1.

During the period of October through December 1988 a surge of unrest directed against the (US/Japanese) military defense establishment will follow a predictable pattern. Students will demonstrate and manifest in about October 1988. Military-related industrialists will be the butt of similar demonstrations. And in December 1988, Red Army factions will target what was described as a predominantly US (used?) naval base located in the vicinity of Iwaki (ENCLOSURE 2). Access to the facility would reportedly be gained via an associated military air facility located immediately west of the naval base. [Previous reporting of 25 August 1988, indicated an intent of a small group of personnel to crash through a gate in several automobiles]. Uprising in Papua New Guinea that are somehow racially motivated occur in November 1988.

The high probability of a "coup d'etat" foreseen to occur in South Korea remains valid; it will be addressed in a separate and subsequent session.

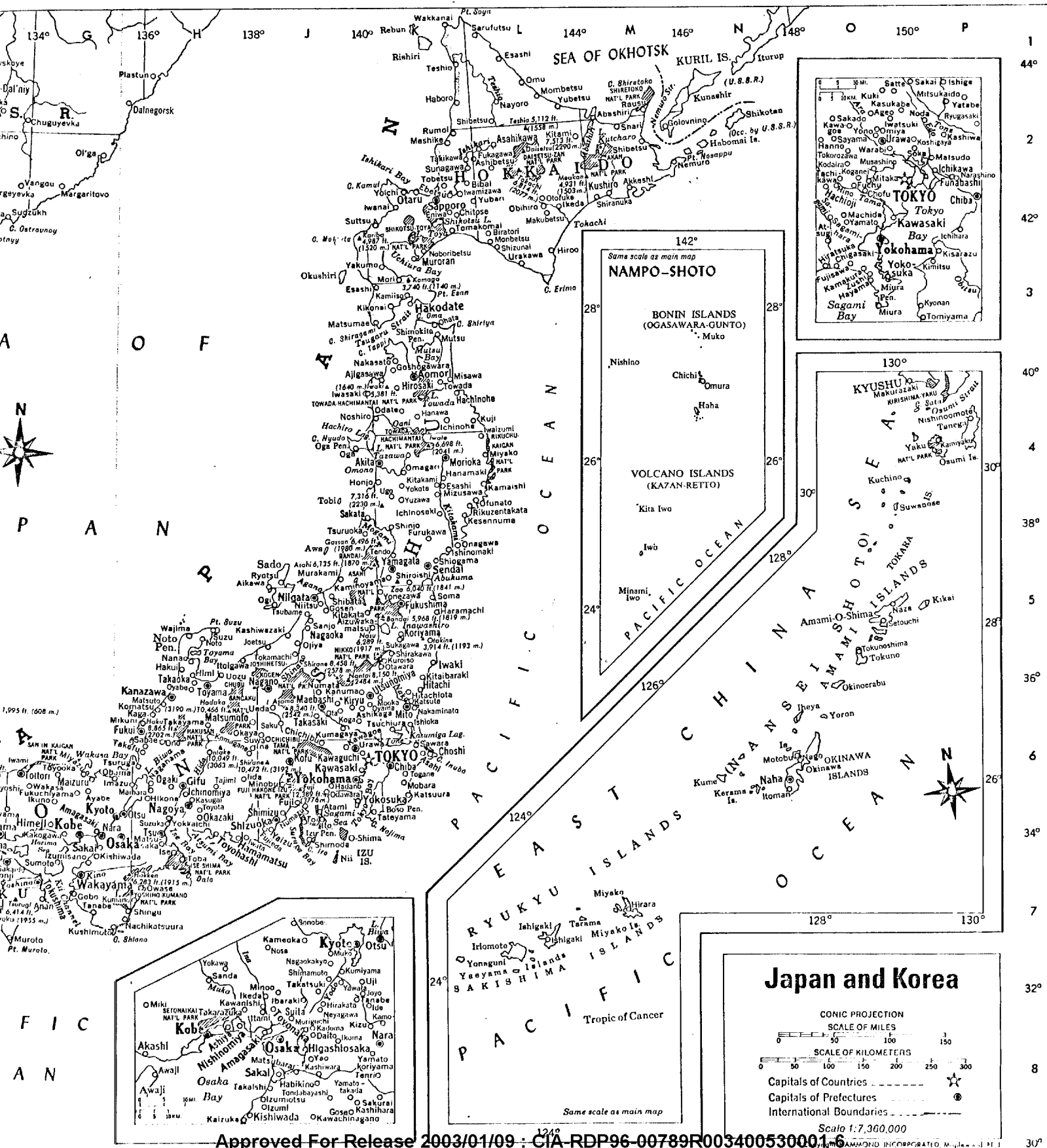
