Target (Higgins) was in a cramped V-shaped room, lying on canvas. He was exhausted and cramped. I got a repeating visual (AOL/S) of the hold in the very bottom front of a craft where ropes, anchors etc are stored. The craft was large and wide and was an old utility craft (AOL: chubby tugboat/ fishing vessel). In trying to focus in on the original use/utility I got a visual of a man standing over the deck throwing something over the side (couldn't tell if he was throwing a line to another craft/dock or throwing something overboard). Near the front was a diagonal shaped structure on top of the deck like AOL: a pilot's perch (see S-3 sketch). Around the craft was a definite thick rim. The deck was filthy and cluttered with lots of junk (metallic, wooden, wet, gritty, oily), boxes etc. which pertained to the original purpose of the craft. There was a strong sensation of an on-going charade--that the craft was trying to appear innocuous. At night-time another smaller craft, a speed boat with two men was circling the vessel. During the day the craft was alone, paralleling the coast. There were at least five men on board and they were angry and tense. The craft was small enough that they felt like they were "on top of each other" and this caused lots of squabbling.
