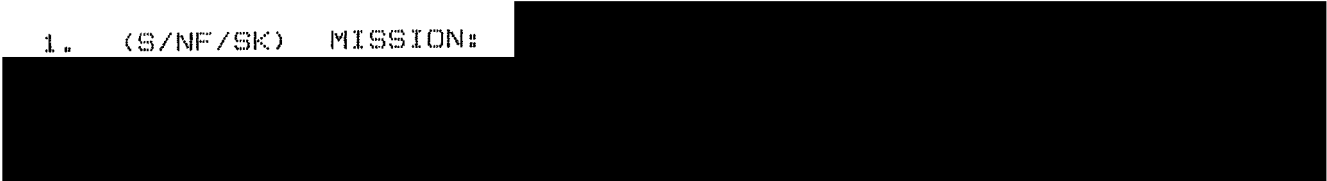

The target vessel previously identified (by this office) under the alias of [REDACTED] and subsequently identified (by the customer) as the [REDACTED] changed its name to the "Delphine Purse/Delfine Purse/Del Fimne-Purse" (phonetic) at the time it crossed the Panama Canal.

The current location of the target vessel is indicated as being south of Flamingo, Florida.

A second vessel known phonetically as the [REDACTED] is in a position to open communications and instruct the target vessel on plans and intentions related to the disposition of the illegal contraband in the form of illegal drugs.
