2. (S-SS) Cueing:

a. Access and describe the person described in previous session, associated with coordinates 681001/187811. (see 3 a. through 3 c., below).

b. Ascertain his title/position (see 3 d., below).

c. Is he involved in diplomatic tasks (Y/N)? If so, describe the scope and value of his diplomatic undertakings. (see 3 e., below).

d. What is he waiting for? (see 3 f., below)

3. (S-SS) Results:

a. The beginning impressions (zeroing in) were very strongly that of dry rocky/sandy land with stucco- or adobe-type buildings. These buildings had a strange architectural formation (see drawing, page 1 of session transcript). I was able to access the man in a setting which had an emotional package of "at grandmother's house" (quiet, peaceful, secure, warm, bright, etc.).

b. Once the man, himself, was accessed, the perceptions of the surrounding area changed to that of very large, official buildings. It had a feel of Washington D.C. (or equivalent city) about it. This man was dwarfed by the gigantic size of the buildings, but his mental attitude was that of being capable of controlling what they hold. He felt

"right to be there", but he also felt a slight "smugly successful invader" feeling.

c. This man has a strong feeling that he is on a road which will easily lead him into a position of control. He presently feels "officially outside the channels of control", but also feels that this "attached outsider" status gives him a special kind of power; namely the kind he needs right now. One thing must be kept in mind about him: he has an all-encompassing certainty that all things are working together to bring him to his goal. He is very intelligent, observant, and is constantly aware of hidden meanings within events.

d. He is in a very important position. He has worked his way here very easily and sees no reason why progress shouldn't continue. His present job is as a representative of his (firm or country), but his feelings that this job is nothing more than a stepping stone toward his goal keeps me from getting a good perception of who he works for and what he does. He feels, above all else, that he is working for his own future, and little else. When I ask him why he is working toward his goal, I get visuals of scarred, dry land and very thin, dark skinned people (AOL: like in Ethiopia). He perceived himself as providing "his grandmother's house" to these people ("his grandmother's house" was a package of peaceful/old-fashioned/warm/secure/etc feelings which directly matched the feelings he had when I first accessed him in 3 a., above). The feeling of care and concern he had for this place and these people was not the same as love for someone, but more the feeling of loving pride one has in his favorite pet animals.

e. SCOPE & VALUE: Trying harder to access his present activities, I got perceptions that he was in the process of demonstrating, lecturing, teaching, informing, going to people in large buildings, etc. I got a strong feeling that he has a close familiarity with a country's leader's office (AOL: U.S. President). His tasks seem to be carried out at the highest level of government.

f. WHAT IS HE WAITING FOR? He doesn't see himself as "waiting". He sees himself as progressing along right on schedule. I was constantly overwhelmed by his inner warmth, assuredness, friendliness, and sense of "being an integral part of predestination". There is the perception that he

views the violence of others as a necessary part of the progress, but that he mentally ignores the harsh realities of it. He perceives his final objective as being higher and more powerful than the U.S. Presidency. He sees himself as one day controlling many countries which are somehow related (AOL: Arab states). 12-26

g. The session ended with a Stage VII attempt to perceive place or personal names. Doubtful results (see page 6 of the session transcript).
