2. (S-SS) Cueing:

- a. View and describe the target event.
- b. Sketch the event and nearby gestalts from overhead.
- 3. (S-SS) Results:
 - a. The site seems to be a round place of high land. This high land rises gradually then drops suddenly down to a very (AI: ugly) flat spot (see Fig. 1). The high land is topped by a very white cloud (AOL: like a head of cauliflower). The cloud is coming from a circular place in the high land. Near the high land is a road which leads down to a city (see Fig 2).
 - b. Impressions of the city included:
 - 1) "Japanese" feel which broke out to:
 - a) very close living conditions
 - b) "rural" feeling for so dense a population
 - c) low wooden (almost stick) houses with thick roofs sandwitched between larger stone buildings (no zoning) (see Fig. 3).

d) all people are light-skinned and wearing strange (to me) dress.

- f) "Godzilla attacking Tokyo" type of panic (people running around, yelling/ people trapped under collapsing buildings/ danger from above / etc.) ALL SOUNDS WERE MUPFLED,
- There seemed to be a haziness or cloudiness, which was accompanied by a "skin-crawling" feel.
- 3) Everything seemed to be covered by white/grey "stuff" (AOL: like snow) which had a dry, heavy, powdery, "gritty" feel to it. It felt like walking on piles of powder (dry and much finer than sand) under bare feet.
- c. I began to doubt the authenticity of the impressions when I realized that I had probably slipped into an AOL drive of "The last days of Pompey". Session ended.
