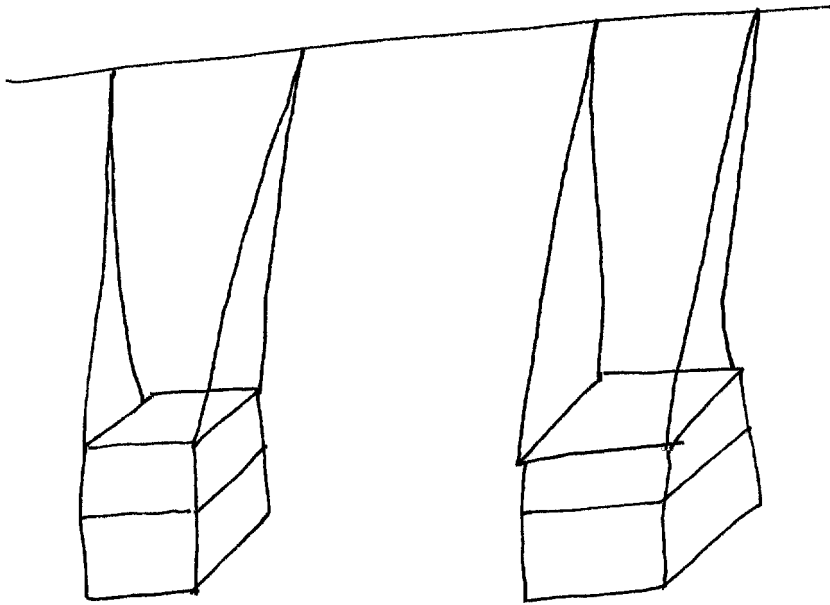

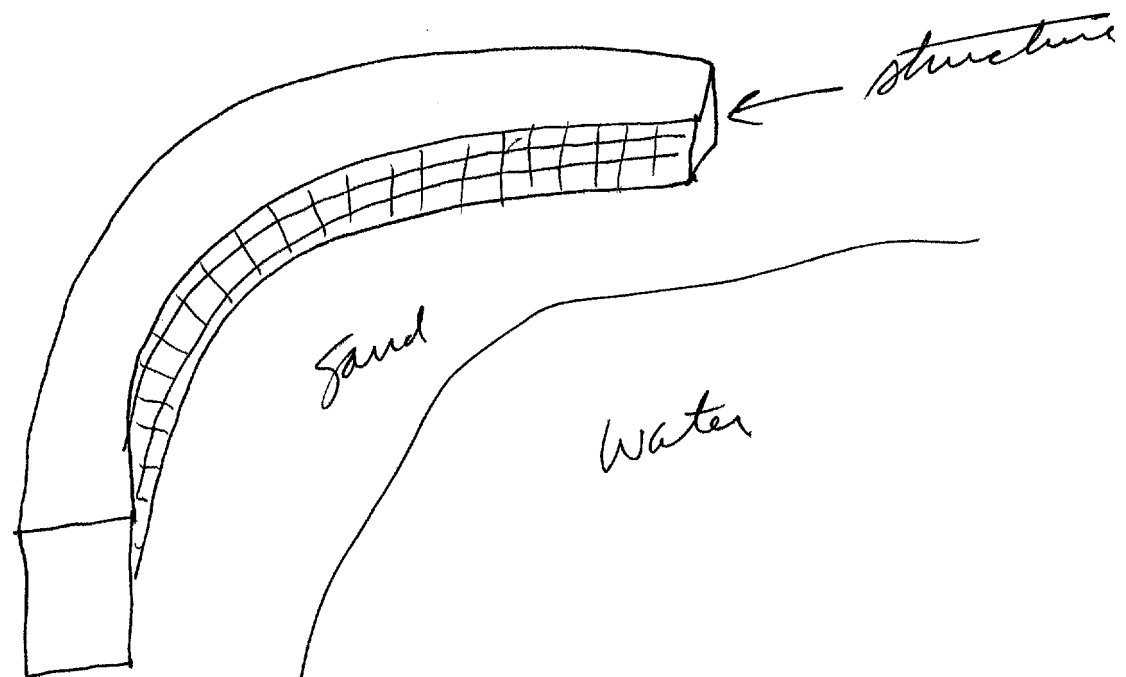
The surrounding is very bright white and it is difficult to ascertain rather it is snow, ice or water. There is a spectacular view of the surrounding area.

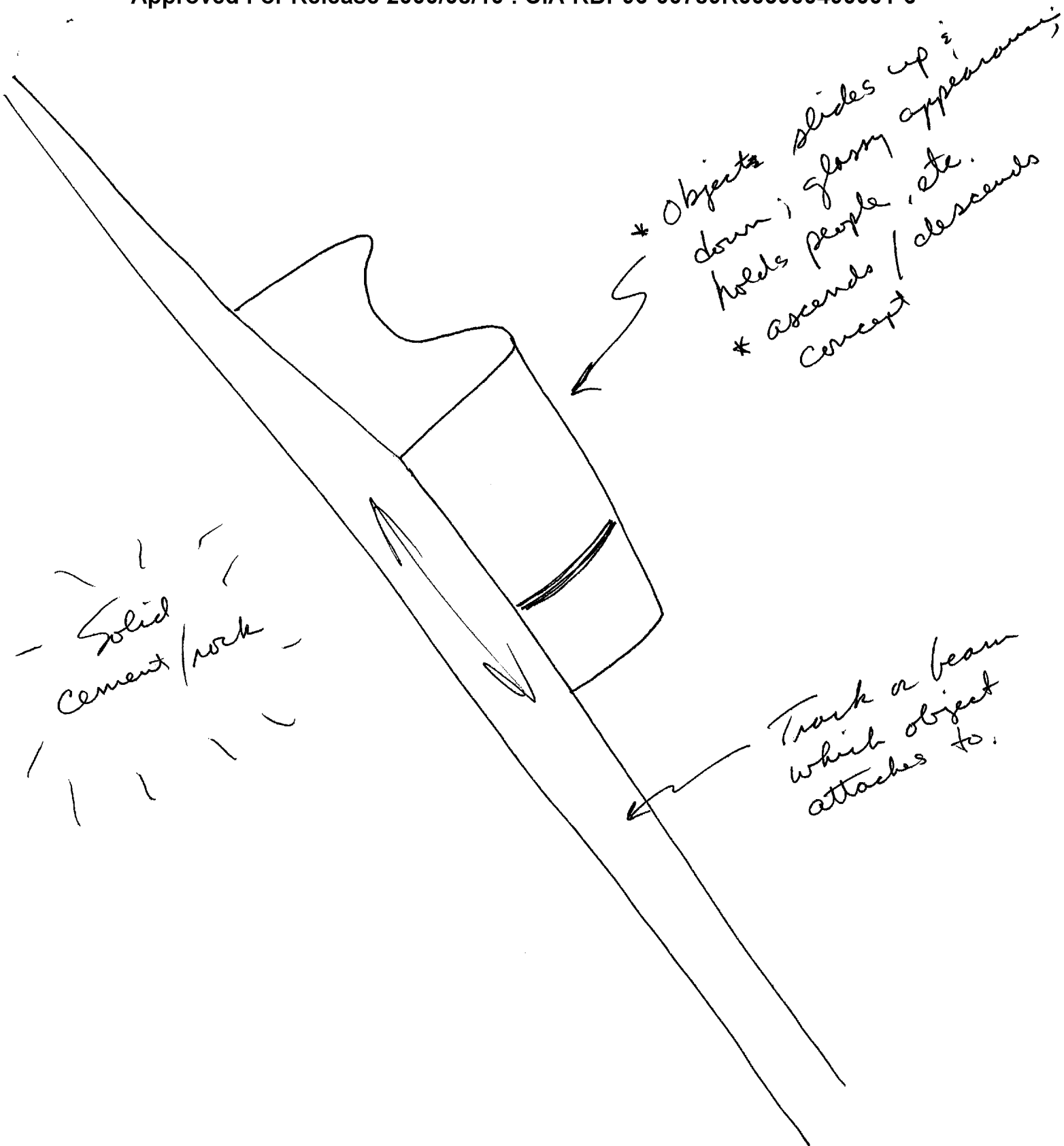

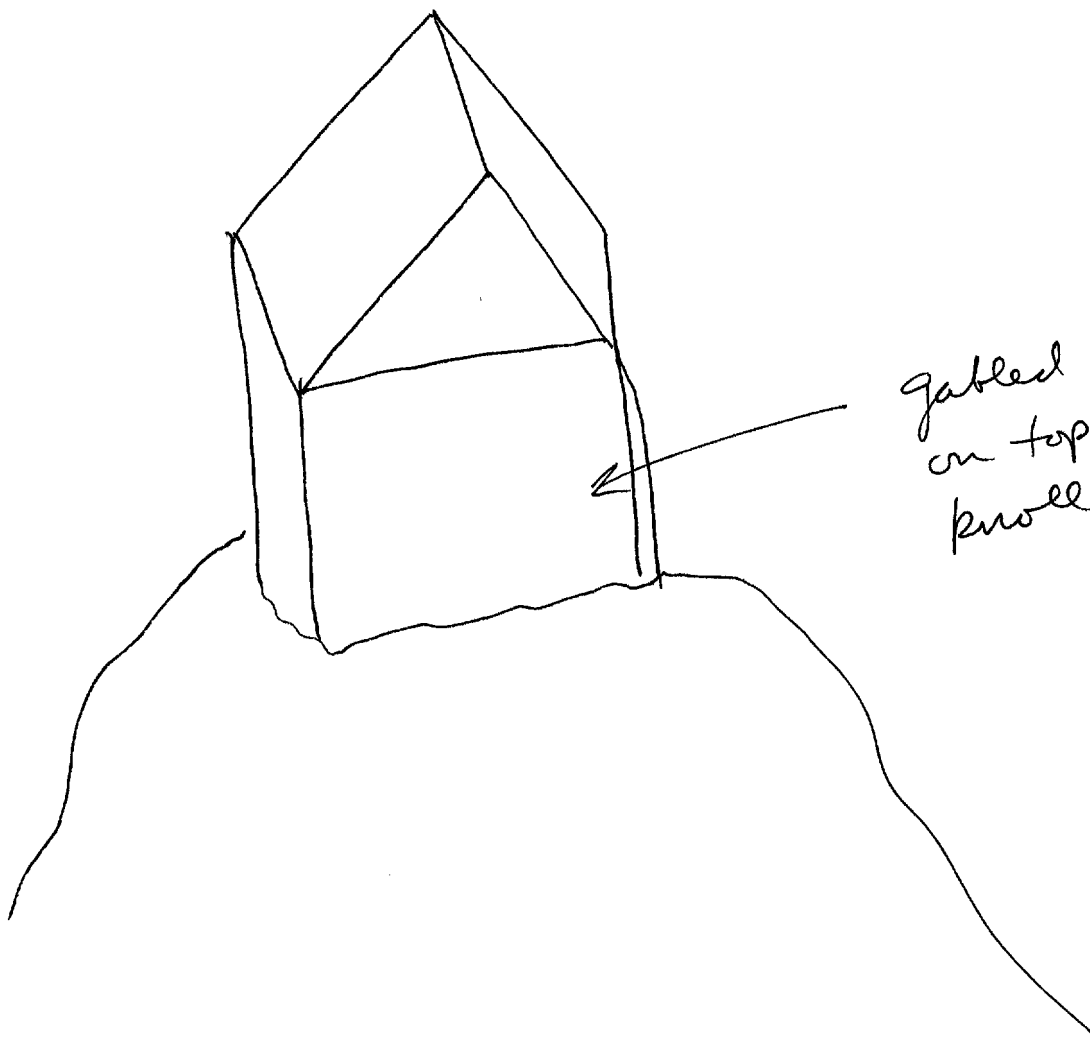
* Concept of hanging "suspensions"

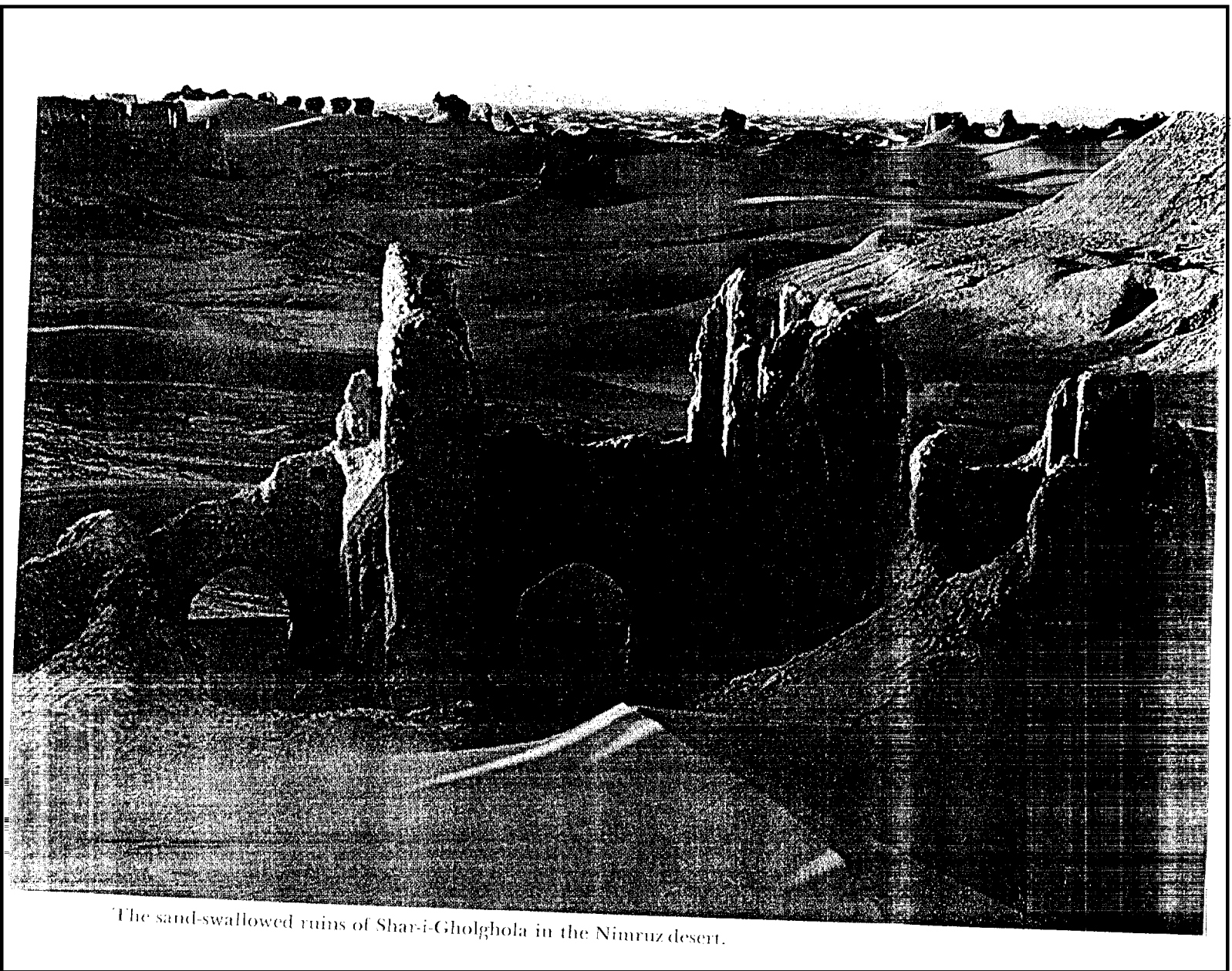


A/s: concept of hotel / office bldg w/ exposed elevators
