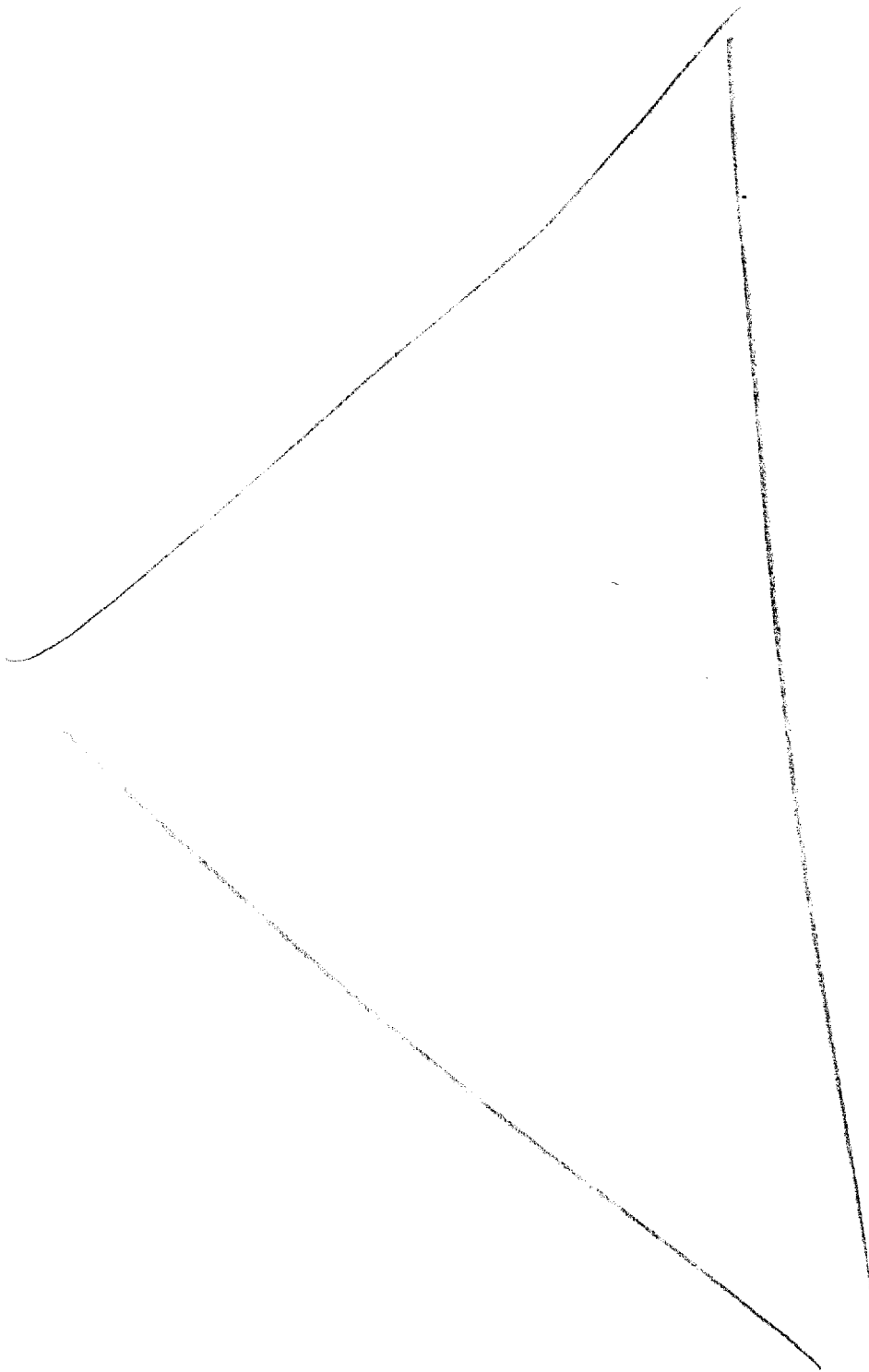

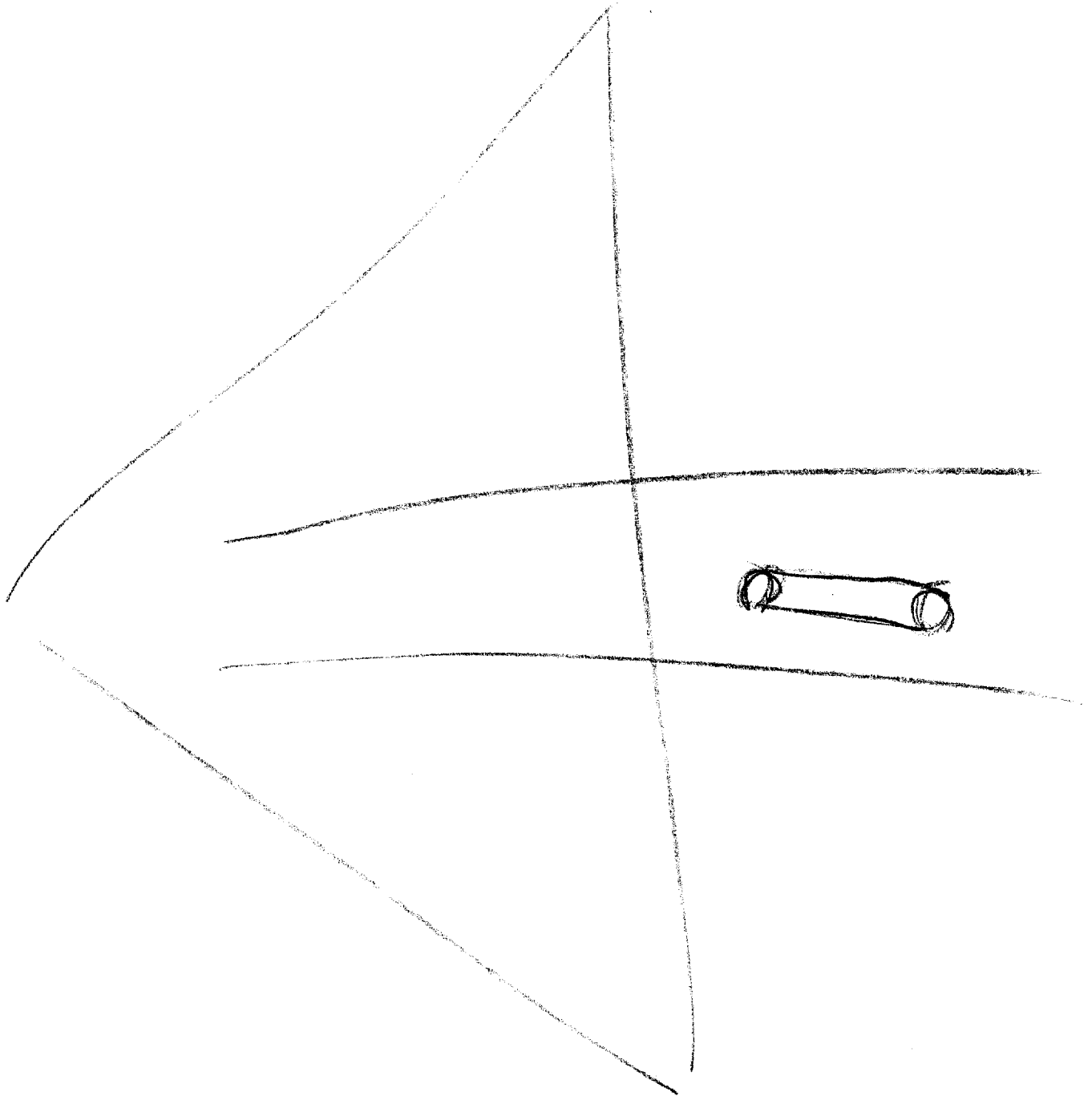

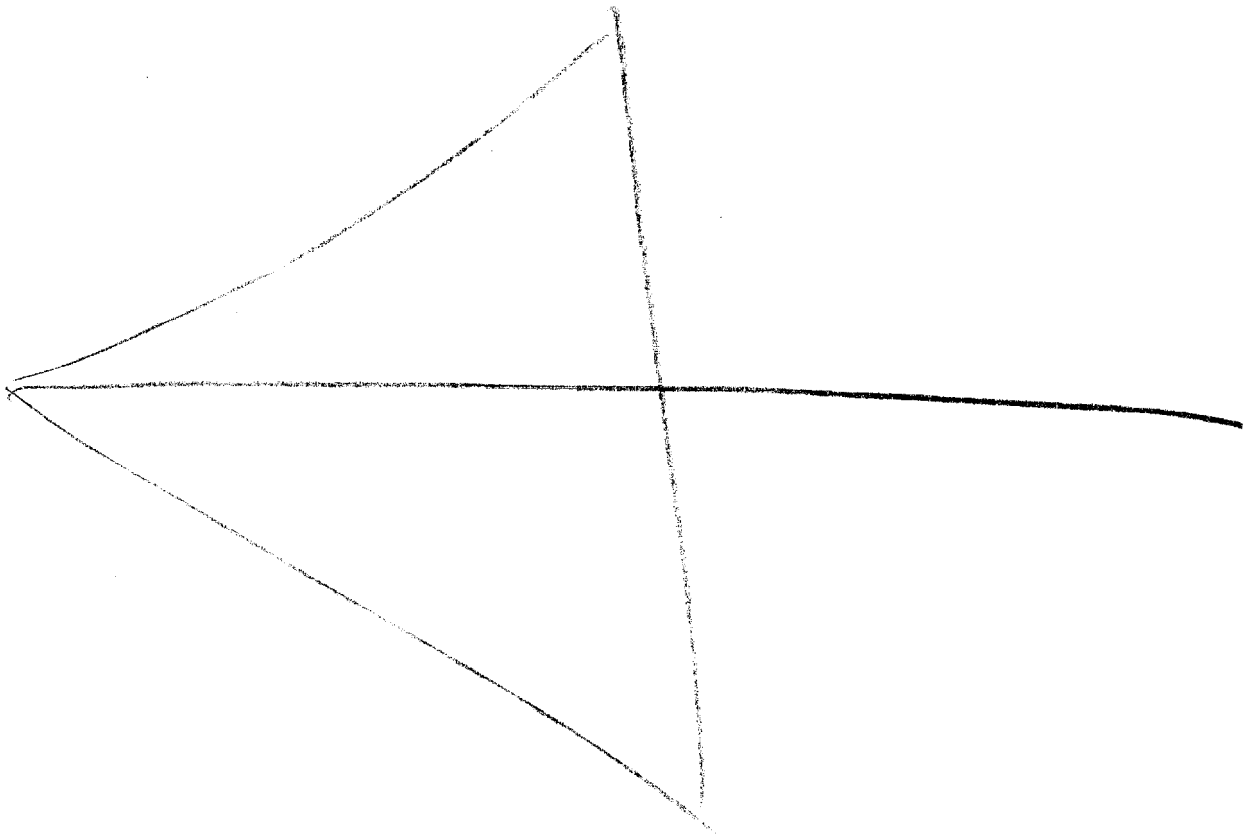
There is activity and motion associated with the site. The activity consists of a "rolling" effect of some type of small circular objects. After the rolling effect, these small circular objects go up and down.

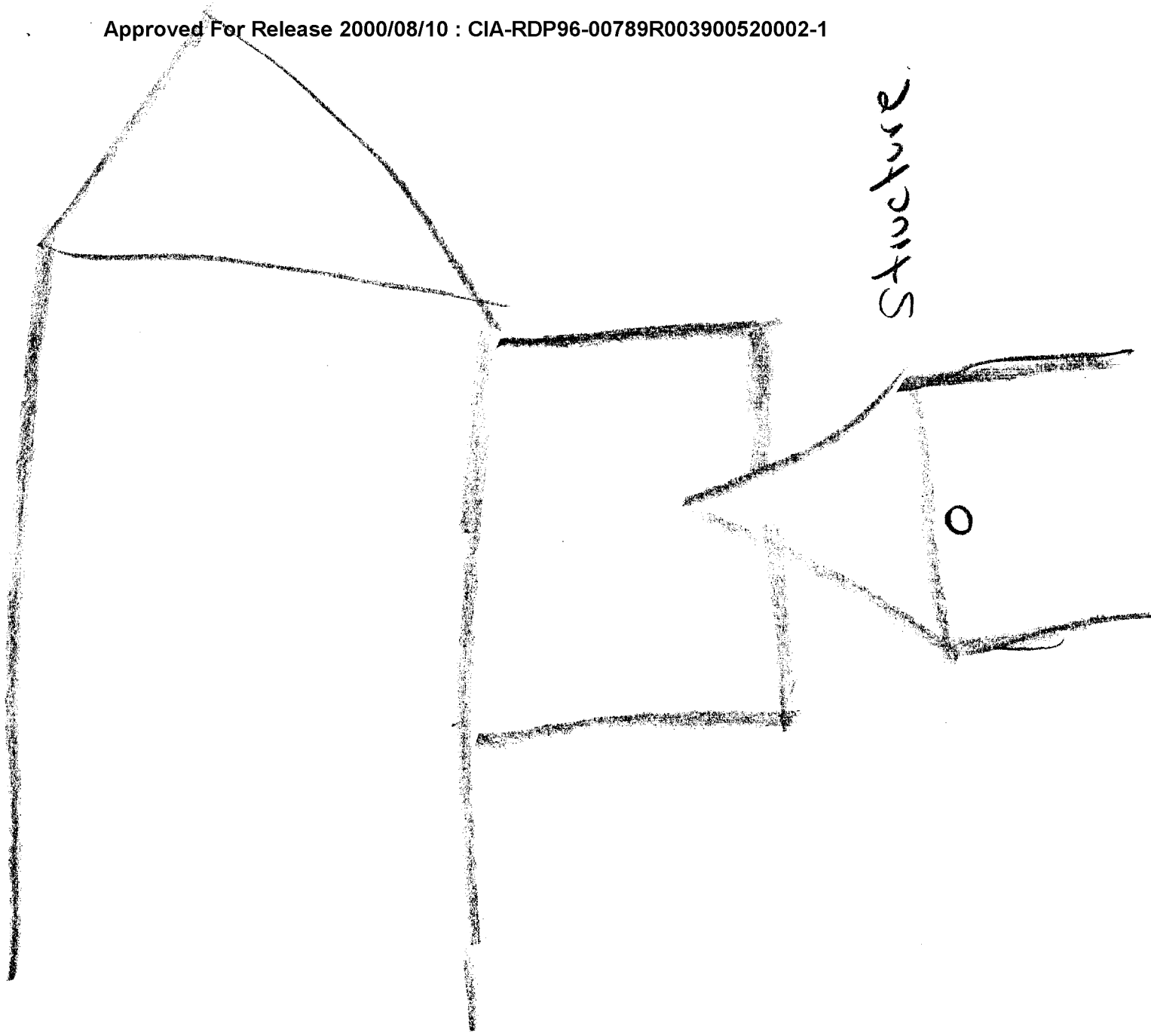
Men come here to take part in the activity.

It can get windy at the site and water may be at the site. Green, white, and blue are associated with the site.



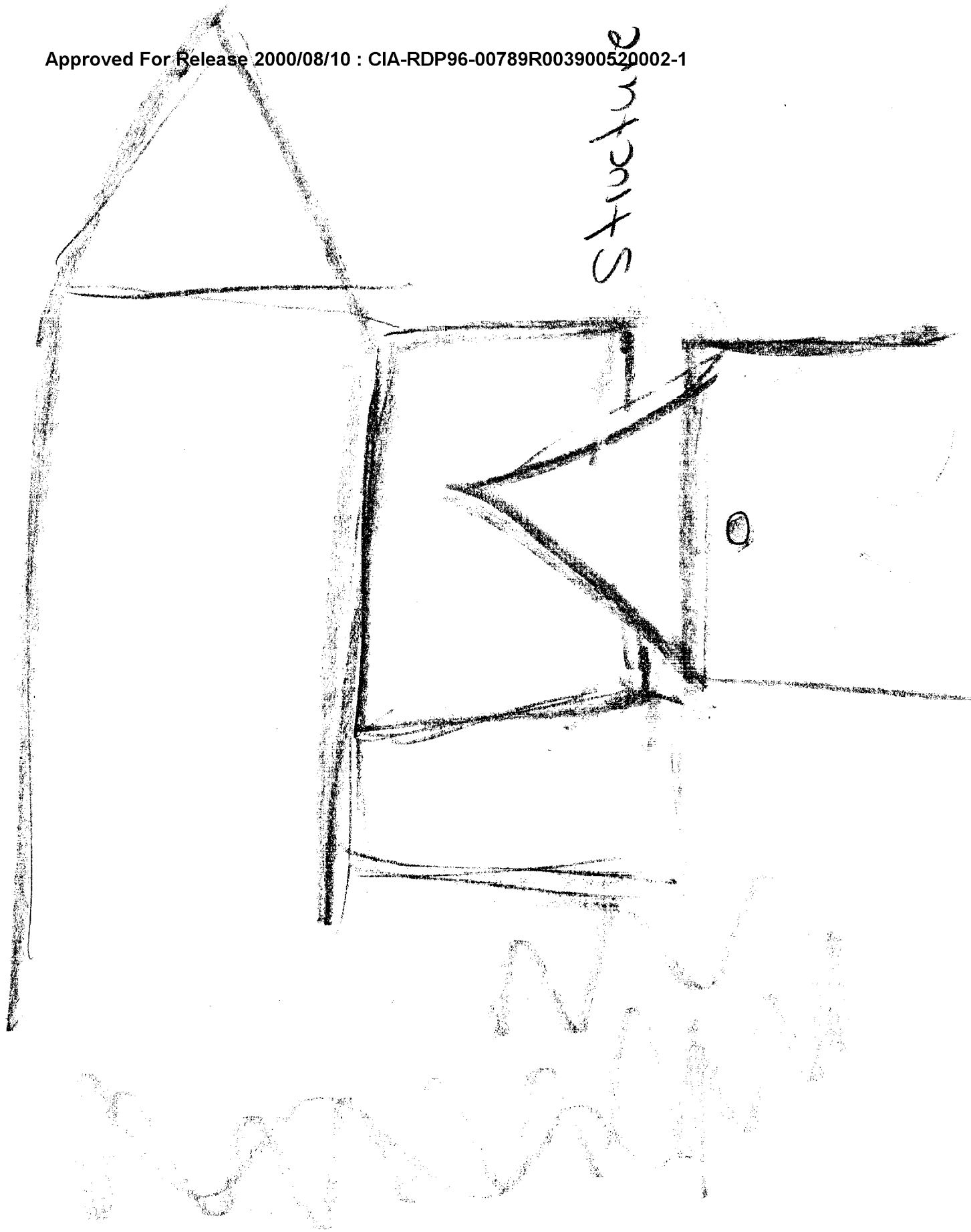


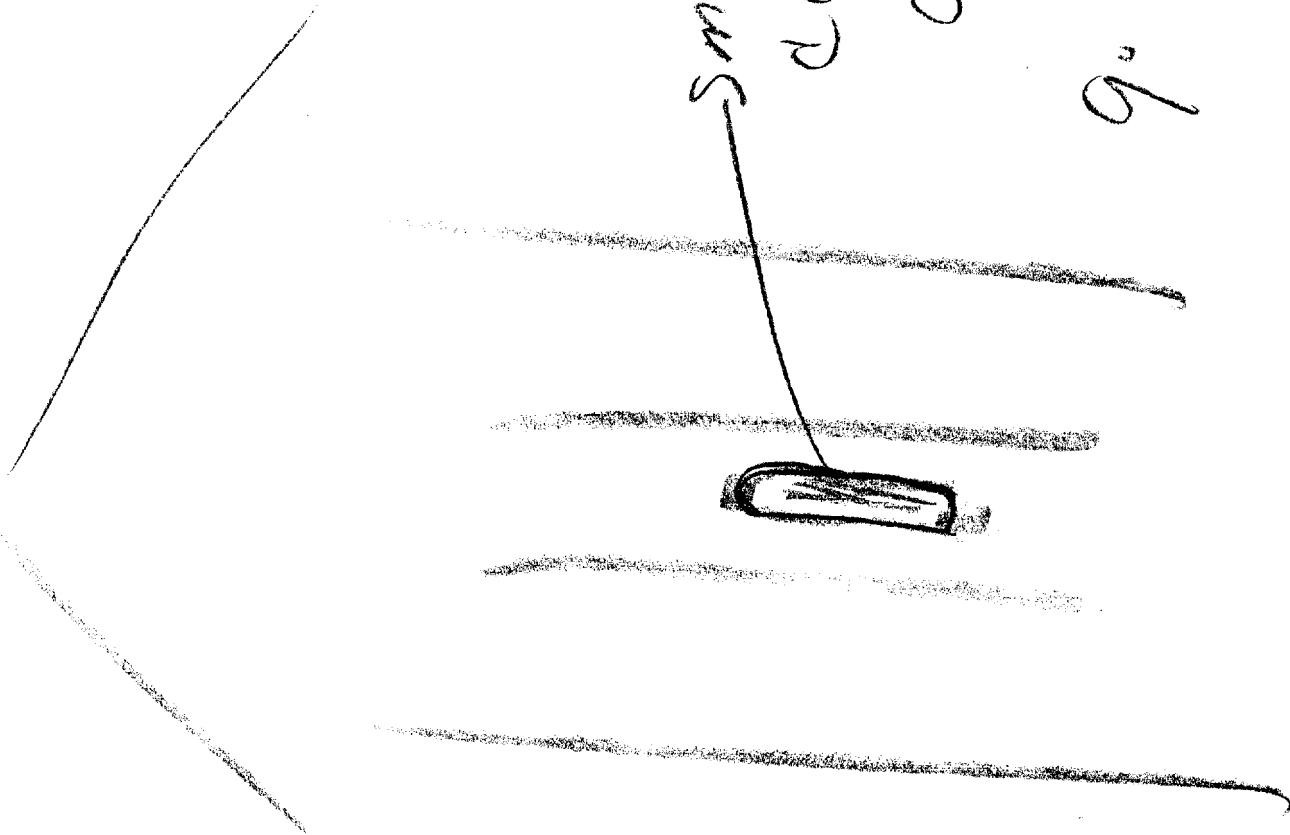
