MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Subject: Support in Establishing Blue Ribbon Panel at National Research Council (NRC) to Evaluate Paranormal Studies Program

1. Purpose

This document defines the working relationship and responsibilities between the US Army Research Institute (ARI), which and the Central Intelligence agency (CIA), Office of Research and Development (ORD) for support in establishing a Blue Ribbon Panel at the National Research Council (NRC) to evaluate various government-sponsored studies in paranormal phenomena.

2. Background

1. In FY 1995, Congress directed that a government- sponsored program be transferred from another government Agency to CIA by July 1, 1995. Congress also directed a retrospective review of past program activities. This review requires an inventory and analysis of the relevant files at the various government agencies where this program has been conducted in the past. CIA has already taken steps to assemble a collection of unclassified documents representative of the program.

The CIA's Office of Research and Development (ORD) believes that the National Research Council (NRC) is the single best organization to perform the mandated review. This is because of its Congressional charter to address questions of Congressional interest, and its ready access to a variety of world-class experts having expertise in the area in question. Since ARI has managed past and current efforts at the NRC to evaluate programs relating to behavioral science, ARI is the natural executive Agency to manage NRC in it's performance of this review. In addition, the urgency of Congress' request makes it impossible for CIA to establish an independent relationship with NRC and still meet the Congressional deadlines.
