After some discussion, the consensus of the Group seemed to be that it would be desirable to postpone the zero hase review for product clearances until we start implementing the program, but to continue to carry out the zero base review for operational clearances. I think this makes a lot of sense and would advise you to assent to this change.
3. Staff Position: I have discussed this question with the Director of Security, and he concurs in my proposal.
4. Recommendation: That you authorize the Director of Security to defer the zero base review product clearances until the implementation phase of the program, but instruct him to complete the zero base review for holders of operational clearances.
