Program, Thursday, 3 August at 1000

1. Jack Anderson Commentary is a regular radio feature which lasts about 3-5 minutes in which Jack asks a celebrity questions about current events. It is carried locally on WRC (NBC affiliate) and aired twice daily, usually around noon and repeated again in the early evening. The program is also carried by some 300 radio stations affiliated with the Mutual Broadcasting Company.

2. You will be interviewed by Howard Rosenberg who works on Jack Anderson's staff. He will ask the questions that will be later repeated by Anderson with your answers.

3. Mr. Rosenberg states that he does not wish to get into controversial areas; promises he will not be argumentative and assures me the questions will not be altered by Anderson. He did, however, state that he will ask you topical questions about such things as the need for clandestine services; your thoughts on the secrecy agreement; opinion of the Snapp and Stockwell books and whether technology is taking over from human collection. Judging from the tenor of our conversation, I think it will be a good opportunity for a stronger need for protecting secrets and the continued need for a stronger CIA.
