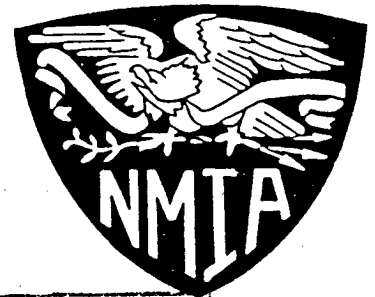


Dear Dr. Gates:
