[^{of this office}] I reviewed the files on subject at DYCLEAR. The documents consist of CSOIC Preliminary Interrogation Report 150, dated 22 June 1946, and final report 85, dated 27 July 1946, of subject. These reports were checked with our form xx and the following discrepancies were noted:

^{in 1938} In the CSOIC report subject stated that he joined the LN Regt 12 at Frankfurt/M and served with this unit on the "Westwall" in 1939-40. On the form xx, subject stated that he joined the German Air Force in 1939 and after a short training period transferred to OKW (German High Command) as an analyst of enemy propaganda and east-Asian questions.

On both forms, subject related his academic mission to Japan ^{in 1941} but ~~on~~ the CSOIC he states that he was transferred back to OKW and ~~on the form xx he points out that the transfer was at his own request back to Germany and called up as a Staff Corporal, with the LN Regt 123 at Beauville, France; on the form xx this duty is not mentioned. That he closed out his wartime service in an airborne unit (ABTO I 4) and served with the Div unit is noted on both forms. His various capacities however ~~is~~ are~~

added in the CSBIC to show insignificance
and in the form XX to show responsibility.
These differences ~~are~~ interpret as signs of
the Times (1946 vs. 1952). The subject realizes
the change of position and is reviewing
his wartime German activities accordingly.
